






Leveled Percentages for Reading


Social Studies Percent of Students Scoring NAPD








Celebrations

- Although test scores are not satisfactory to us, we are still comparable to those surrounding us.
- We are confident that we have research based systems in place to help close many of the gaps we are seeing.
- Students consistently show that they receive quality instruction, are loved, are in a safe environment, and consistently have staff members who care for them.
- Even though students report that bullying is a problem, data shows that:
 - o 71% of students say they are taught ways to stop bullying if it occurs.
 - o 85% of students say they know safe ways to report bullying.
 - o 85% of students say that bullying reports are handled effectively.

Areas of Growth

- We need to continue to address many of the social issues that students are seeing at school.
- We need to sure up the instructional foundations that we have somewhat lost through the CoVid years.

 Administration needs to be involved consistently in instructional planning PLCs and targeted supports for students academically, emotionally, and mentally.
