

MUNICIPAL ORDER 03-2023

A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$5,352,167.00 TO FACILITATE UPGRADES TO THE STORM SEWER DRAINAGE SYSTEM IN THE YORK PARK AREA TO MITIGATE LOCALIZED FLOODING.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has HMGP (Hazard Mitigation Grant Program) funds available for the purpose of supporting local communities in undertaking hazard mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Owensboro desires to apply for funds in the amount of Five Million Three Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$5,352,167.00) from FEMA so that it can reconstruct the existing storm sewer system with larger conveyances as well as disconnection from the combined sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Owensboro agrees to the local share of twenty-five percent (25%) of the project cost in the amount of One Million Three Hundred Thirty-Eight Thousand Forty-One Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$1,338,041.75);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the City of Owensboro to apply for funding in the amount of Five Million Three Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars (\$5,352,167.00) from FEMA.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the formal grant agreement with FEMA for funding through the HMGP (Hazard Mitigation Grant Program).

Section 3. The Mayor, City Manager and other appropriate staff members are hereby authorized to sign any and all other agreements, instruments or documents deemed necessary in furtherance of the authority outlined herein.
