Recommendation/Motion: Approve the Construction Documents and Advertisement for Bids for replacement of the artificial turf, refurbishment of track, and the replacement of the field lights at Tates Creek High School football field.

Background/Rationale: Due to normal life cycle and wear-and-tear, the artificial turf field at Tates Creek High School is coming to the end of its expected life. The track is due for refurbishing, which means that it will be receiving a new structural overspray, new striping, and event markings. The lights on this field were initially installed in the early 1970s, are not energy efficient and need to be replaced. The initial BG-1 Project Application for the construction, identifying the extent and cost of the work, was approved by the Board at its November 28, 2022 meeting.

The athletic directors and coaches have been consulted, and it has been determined that the project should move forward as quickly as possible so as to produce the least disturbance with sports activities at the school and to be completed at the earliest possible date. Due to the year-round use of this athletic field for events and team practices there is a very small window of opportunity to complete the work. To avoid conflicts the current schedule is to begin the replacement for the turf around June 2023 and the track would be resurfaced after the turf is completed to be finished before spring 2024.

At this time, the Board is required by 702 KAR 4:160 to indicate acceptance of the Construction Documents prepared by the design consultants, Ross Tarrant Architects. **The Board's approval of the Construction Documents and advertisement is requested at this time in order to maintain this schedule.**
