We repaired unit HP-150.1 at Jefferson Elementary and completed the startup.

Once we removed the evaporator coil we found that someone had drilled a hole in the coil. We initially ordered the coil under Water Furnace warranty. However, the hole in the coil is obvious damage done after manufacture and will not be covered by the manufactures warranty. The discussion I had with the technician it looks like whomever installed the fire alarm wiring was the one who drilled the hole in the coil.

While we were performing the repair it was also found that someone had drilled a hole in the evaporator drain pan. We did seal the hole using silicone and a spray sealant. If this does leak in the future we would need to remove both evaporator coils to replace the drain pan.

I have attached the updated quote including the cost of the coil and drier. This is the amount we will be billing to the PO provided.
