704 KAR 7:125, KRS 159.030

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact:

The End of Year (EOY) average daily attendance (ADA) will determine the district budget for 2022-2023. House Bill 1 passed by the Kentucky Legislature in August (2022 special session) has a provision for flood-impacted school districts that states if ADA for SY 2022-2023 decreases by 3% or more than ADA from SY 2018-2019, the ADA for calculation of SEEK paid during SY 2023-2024 shall be increased by 2/3 of the decrease.

History/Background:

The fourth attendance month has been our lowest yet this year and ended with the cancellation of school December 13, 14, 15, and 16 for illness. Lowest days of the fourth month include the two days before Thanksgiving Break (85.77% on 11/21 and 77.51% on 11/22) and the three days leading up to the cancellation of school (85.37% on 12/8, 82.85% on 12/9, and 84.10% on 12/12). The fifth and current attendance month will end on January 26.

Schools are continuing to focus on rebuilding attendance habits. The trend that we continue to see is that the number of excused absences are up as compared to past pre-covid years. Schools continue to make calls home daily and to meet in weekly Attendance PLCs where they tweak their school attendance plans and discuss the attendance of individual students as well as student groups. Truancy Court is operational in all attendance areas.
