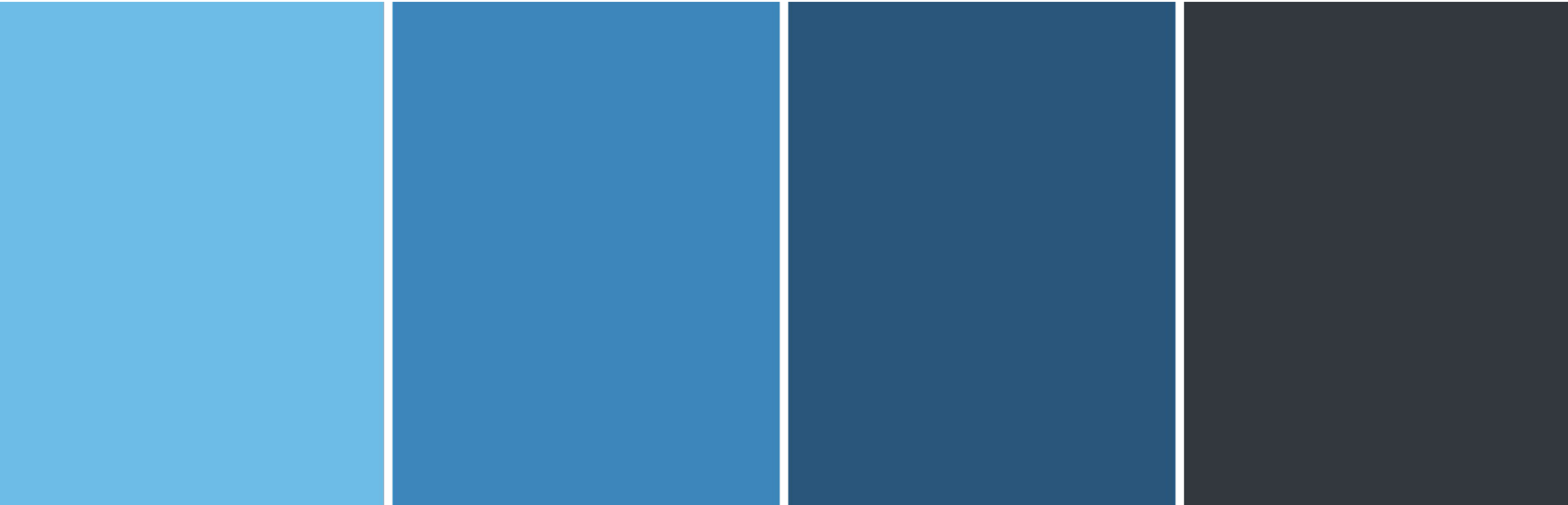

Volunteer assessments were completed on December 15th  
at CCHS & HHS

1. Review of Christian County School District website
2. Review of HHS and CCHS websites
3. Observed supervision practices and procedures
4. Review of posted evacuation routes
5. Review of the school's Emergency Management Response Plan
6. A physical plant walk-through
7. Results of a safe schools survey for students, staff and parents
8. Interviews with students, staff and parents
