

Dayton High School Board Report Wednesday, January 25th, 2023



- YSA (Young Scholars Academy) Update First Semester Results of 14 Students attending Northern Kentucky University:
  - o Grade Summary Our students earned the following in their courses (14 students took 5 courses each for a total of 70 courses)-
    - 44 A's
    - 19 B's
    - 5 C's
    - 1 D
    - 1 F
  - o Four of our students earned all A's.
  - All fourteen students are continuing in the program. There is a plan in place with the university for the student who did have the two lower grades to help ensure their success this semester.

## Opportunities outside DHS for students:

- Six seniors, who are currently NOT post-secondary ready, have chosen to take a Digital Literacy course online through Gateway. As long as each student passes the course with a C average, they will graduate being post-secondary ready.
- Two senior students will be piloting our school-to-work program where they will be employed by a local company and need to clock 148 hours by the end of the school year to earn a work-based experience credit. This will count as an elective credit. Hopefully in the future more seniors who are on track to graduate will be able to take part in the program.
- Army National Guard representative met with seniors on 1/19.
- Two juniors students will begin their Logistics Co-op at DHL and Cengage while continuing the Gateway Logistics courses online.



- Twelve sophomore students applied for the Young Scholars Academy (YSA) for the 2023-2024 school year
  - o A meeting was held after the parent conferences on January 17th.
    - Seven students and parents attended meeting in the library.

    - Pass every class in the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter
    - 2 or less referrals (fighting/vape incident automatically disqualifiers)
