Honor Roll - We had 92 total students on the Honor/Super Honor Roll for the 2nd Quarter of school from 4th – 6th grades. To celebrate this big accomplishment, students received an in-school dance with a pizza party.

Gifted Book Fairs - The Scripps Howard Foundation gifted Scholastic Book Fair will be held this upcoming week of January 2023. EACH student in grades preschool through 6th grade will receive FIVE student selected books and a free water bottle. The second book fair will be gifted at the end of this school year.

Family Engagement Day #3 - Lincoln teachers and staff invited our Lincoln families in for our third Family Engagement Conference on Tuesday, January 17th. We are working at reaching 100% of our families by the end of this week. We focused the day's family discussions in these areas:

- Student Strengths – Shared and discussed EACH student's strengths.
- Volunteer Menu – Menu provided to our families to give them ways to become involved and to help our great school in different ways.
- Family Needs Brochure – Brochure given to families to share all of the supports and resources we have in place here at Lincoln.

Benchmark Assessments – Our students completed their AIMSweb and STAR assessments in December before their winter break. We are pleased with the students' growth progress and have used this important winter data to create our new WIN ("What I Need") groups that began on January 10th. These groups are created to meet students' academic needs. Each grade level's 7-10 WIN groups consist of groups for Gifted and Talented, on grade level and also intervention.

School Play – Auditions have been held for our spring production of Disney Jr. Moana. The play will be held the weekend of April 21st – April 23, 2023. We are so excited for this opportunity for our students!
