### CONDITIONS FOR APPROVAL

Tuition students will be accepted provided that space is available, and that the student meets established criteria for acceptance. Criteria includes: (1) Space availability —projected enrollment not to exceed State guidelines for maximum class size; (2) Academic performance data and District admission tests and student transcript; (3) Attendance; (4) Behavior - the student must not have been suspended or expelled from the sending school during the past school year; and (5) payment of \$25.00 enrollment processing fee and tuition.

Non-resident tuition students, if accepted, are enrolled for one (1) school year only. At the end of the school year, the performance of the student, academically and behaviorally, will be evaluated to determine continued enrollment. If, at any time during the school year, a space availability problem, academic problem(s) or behavior problem(s) develops, or tuition is not paid as agreed upon in a timely manner, the non-resident tuition student may have his/her enrollment terminated.

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due on or before the last Friday in July, in order to hold your child's place. This payment will be applied to the tuition balance.

## **Contract/Conditions for Non-Resident Tuition Students**

In the event of court action to enforce this agreement, Beechwood shall be entitled to its costs of collection including reasonable attorney fees.

For non-resident students the tuition schedule will be as follows:

Full-Time Students Grades K-12 \$3,800/year (with ADA received)

Full-Time Students Grades K-12 \$6,000/year (without ADA received)

For non-resident students from out-of-state school districts, the tuition schedule will be as follows:

Out-of-State Students

Grades K-12

\$6,200/year

For children of Beechwood Independent Schools employees\*

No charge

\*\*Out-of-state non-resident children of full-time staff enrolled after August 1, 2017 shall pay a tuition rate equal to the Kentucky state contribution per child for each child enrolled in the District.

Non-resident students are accepted for one (1) year only. Subsequent enrollment after the first year is subject to space availability, academic performance, financial obligations, and behavior of the student while in attendance.

If a resident pupil moves from the District, the student may apply for tuition status; however, acceptance will be based on the results of the admission's process.
