- Demolition of 1st hallway upstairs has begun -- full month ahead of schedule



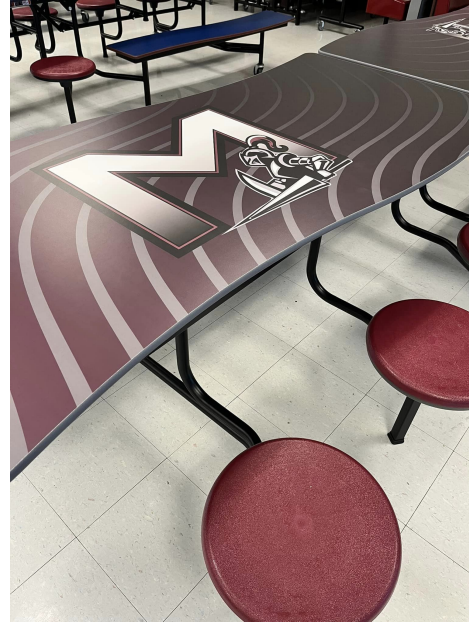
MCHS Update

- MCKA received new seating for the cafeteria recently.



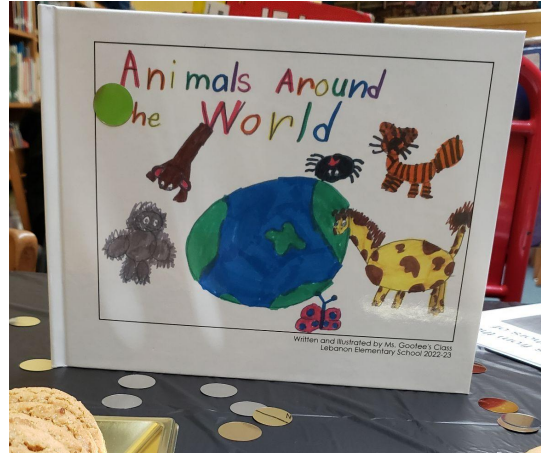
Continuous Improvement

- LES students in Ms. Gootee's 1st/2nd grade class held a book signing for their published book *Animals Around the World*.

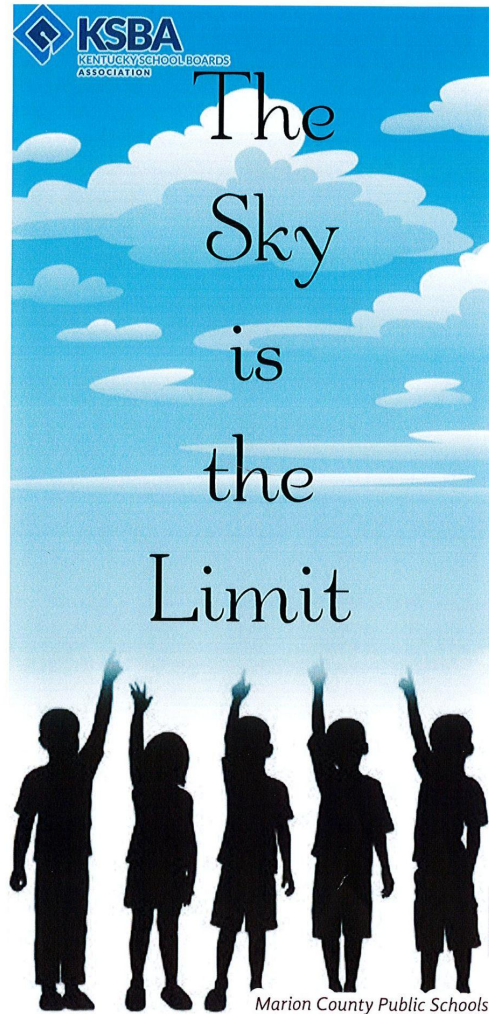


Student Success
