

2023-2024 School Defined Course and Course Code For CCPS Board Approval

The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) requires approval from the local Board of Education for the use of a 909999 course code before a district begins utilizing it within Infinite Campus. Course Code 909999 indicates the course is a "school defined course."

CCPS has a school defined course that it would like to offer, beginning with the 2023-2024 school year. This course is required by Hopkinsville Community College for the Early College Associate's Degree Program. Traditionally, FYE 105 Achieving Academic Success is offered as a Dual Enrollment course. Beginning in the Fall of 2023, it will be offered within the regular school day to Sophomores pursuing the Associate's Degree Program. It would be allowed to count as a high school elective course worth one credit. The course description is as follows:

Location: Gateway Academy Course Code: 909999-FYE 105

Course Name: FYE 105 Achieving Academic Success

Course Credit: 1 HS Elective Credit/Dual Credit 3 Hour HCC Course

Course Description: Introduces students to strategies that promote academic, personal, and professional success in the college environment. Foster a sense of belonging, promotes engagement in the curricular and co-curricular life of the college, and provides opportunities for students to develop academic plans that align with career and life goals.
