Sports Information:

The boys basketball team is currently 20-7. They will play Thursday night at 6:30 for the 6<sup>th</sup> District Championship. Win or lose, they will play in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Region Tournament on either Wednesday, March 1 or Thursday March 2.

The girls basketball team is currently 20-4. They will play on Wednesday night at 6:30 for the 6<sup>th</sup> District Championship. Win or lose, they will play in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Region Tournament on either Monday, February 27 or Tuesday, February 28.

The wrestling team had a very successful year. Naomi Santiago finished 6<sup>th</sup> in the state in her weight class. JJ Poynter was the region runner up in his weight class and qualified for the state tournament. Wyatt Payne and Isazah Wright finished in 5<sup>th</sup> place and are alternates at the state tournament.

The swimming team finished the season with many of the swimmers setting personal records at the region meet. While not qualifying for the state meet, they have shown growth throughout the season.

The bowling team sent Austin Lander in boys singles and Austin Lander and Holden Hobby in the unified division to the state bowling tournament. Austin finished in 4<sup>th</sup> and Austin and Holden finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> in the state.

The archery team has won three tournaments this year and is currently ranked 6<sup>th</sup> in the state.

The track team has been practicing since December 1. They will participate in the KTCCCA State Indoor Championship on March 4. Outdoor season begins on March 18 when we host the Colonel Classic.

Baseball, softball, tennis and bass fishing have started practice and will begin regular season competition soon.
