

**Service Contract
Between
Electric Plant Board
of the City of Russellville
and
Russellville City School System**

This contract for service is entered into this ____ day of _____, 2023 between the Electric Plant Board of the City of Russellville, here-in-after referred to as "EPB", located at 165 East Fourth Street, Russellville, KY and the Russellville City School System, here-in-after referred to as "RCSS", located at 355 South Summer Street, Russellville, KY.

Whereas RCSS has requested the EPB to provide dark fiber service between RCSS's High School located at 1101 West Ninth Street, Russellville, KY, and its Central Office located at 355 South Summer Street, **and** between RCSS's Stevenson Elementary School located at 1000 North Main Street; Russellville, KY and it's Central Office, **and** between the Technology office located at 210 East Seventh Street, Russellville, Ky, and its Central Office. The EPB hereby agrees to provide the requested service under the following terms and conditions:

1. Service will be provided using two (2) strands of fiber optic cable between each school location and the RCSS Central Office, and two (2) strands of fiber optic cable between the Technology Office and the central office.
2. EPB will be responsible for the maintenance of its fiber optic cable between each location and the RCSS Central Office. In the event service between any of the locations and the RCSS Central Office is interrupted due to damage to the EPB's fiber, the EPB will make reasonable effort to have service restored as soon as possible after being notified by RCSS of an interruption of service.
3. Service is defined as the ability to pass light through the fiber optic cable from each school location to the RCSS Central Office.
4. RCSS agrees not to hold the EPB liable for any monetary damages due to the loss or interruption of service that might occur due to acts, whether natural or caused otherwise.
5. RCSS and the EPB agree that the point of demarcation shall be the patch panels located at each of RCSS's location.

6. RCSS agrees that the EPB's responsibility ends at supply side of the respective patch panels and that RCSS is responsible for any equipment and all connections made on the receiving side of the respective patch panels that are required to transmit or receive light.
7. RCSS agrees to pay the EPB \$1100.00 per month.

The effective date of this agreement shall be July 1, 2023 and continue on a month-to-month basis until June 30, 2024, unless terminated by either party in writing.
