



# POWELL COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL

By 2025 Powell County High School will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient/distinguished in

- Reading for HS from 32% (2022) to 52%.
- Math for HS from 20% (2022) to 42.5%.
- Science for HS from 4% to 34%.
- Social Studies for HS from 20% (2022) to 50%.
- Combined Writing/Editing&Mechanics for HS from 44% (2022) to 60%.

By 2025, Powell County High School will increase the

- Postsecondary readiness rate from 75.8 (2022) to 85.
- Climate Index for HS from 57.9 (2022) to 67.9.
- Safety Index for HS from 52.4 (2022) to 62.4.
