Consent Agenda Item (Action Item): Consider adjusting the Floyd County Schools 2022-23 Athletic Handbook Athletic Conference Timeline for the sports of Baseball/Softball. Season Starting Practice Date will remain the same – February 15. Under consideration for Baseball/Softball:

1. Adjust the Season Start Date from March 15 to March 1
2. Adjust the Season End Date from May 27 to April 29
3. Adjust the County Tournament from May 18-20 to May 1-6.

History/Background: The 2022-23 Floyd County Schools Athletic Handbook was approved by the board on July 27, 2022. Since the passage of the Handbook several issues have arisen with the dates as listed.

1. Season End Date and Tournament Begin dates are incorrect (county tournament is BEFORE season end date)
2. Our projected last day of school for this year, with the addition of disaster days, is May 18.
3. Testing is the last 2 weeks of the school year and the tournament would be completed prior to testing beginning, therefore; not interfering with the two-week testing window.

Recommended Action: Approve the above change requests in Baseball/Softball Conference Timeline as outlined.

1. Complies with all KHSAA bylaws and/or policies of the Floyd County Board of Education
2. Provides data as required for Title IX compliance reporting and other district reports as needed
3. Develops team program budget
4. Make travel arrangements and appropriate bus requests
5. Ensures completion of health exam by athletes
6. Monitors athlete attendance/behavior/academic status
7. Maintains first-aid/CPR certification
8. Completes appropriate accident reports immediately following accidents/injuries to student/athletes
9. Ensures athlete is cleared by M.D. in order to return to practice
10. Completes required administrative reports by designated date(s)
11. Instructs team members concerning changes in rules
12. Teaches fundamentals of the sport as outlined by the head coach of that sport
13. Strives to improve skills by attending clinics and using resources made available
14. Supervising players before and after practice
15. Works to instills sportsmanship and fair play
16. Works with principal and athletic director on ordering needed equipment and uniforms and maintenance of equipment and uniforms
17. Conducts practice sessions to develop the individual and team skills to assist the students in performing at their maximum potential
18. Assumes leadership role in developing team rules and guidelines
