Permission to Apply for Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)

The Department of School Nutrition Services (SNS) requests permission to apply for and participate in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) during the months of June and July.

The SFSP ensures that low-income children continue to receive nutritious meals when school is not in session. Free meals are available to all children under the age of 19 years; these meals will be made available at approved SFSP sites in areas with significant concentrations of low-income children. These sites will be located at various places in these low-income communities, such as schools, parks, recreation centers, churches, etc.

This request for 2023 includes the need for, at minimum, fifteen (15) cook/bakers, two (2) kitchen managers and substitutes on an as-needed basis for no more than 40 days. Participation in the SFSP benefits other community programs such as 21st Century and the YMCA of Bullitt County by providing free meals, thus allowing other program funds to go towards education and enrichment activities.
