Hello, my name is Richard Tyler, **President** of the Northern Kentucky Juneteenth Committee, which is planning the Biggest Juneteenth Freedom Day Celebration in Northern Kentucky for this year, we are asking if you would please share this information with others.

The Juneteenth Freedom Day Celebrations is a three-day event that will commemorate the historical significance of the end of *Slavery in the United States*.

The event will kick off on Friday, June 16<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. at the Newport Black History Museum, which was formerly the Southgate Colored People School. The evening will include a guest speaker, performances by The Yolo Band and Rhythm of Soul. Vendor tables and food booths will be available. Exhibits of the Colored People School will also be on display, and the public is welcome to tour the classrooms.

On Saturday June 17<sup>th</sup>, the day begins with the Freedom Day Parade at 9:00 a.m. The Parade will commence at the former Lincoln Grant School at 9<sup>th</sup> & Greenup Streets and end at the Covington Landing, a spot that was considered the *Gateway to Freedom* during slavery. Immediately following the parade, The Black Excellence Awards Ceremony will convene. After the awards ceremony, The Juneteenth Freedom Day Celebration continues with a day-long celebration of speakers, bands, entertainment, *Soul Food* for the entire family. There will also be service providers, health organizations, merchandise vendors and food vendors to showcase their services.

On Sunday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, The Freedom Day will start at 9:00 a.m. at St. Henry Church (Dixie Highway and Garvey Avenue) and conclude at First Baptist Church of Elsmere (1007 Garvey Avenue). At 10:00 a.m. we will have a morning worship service during which The Northern Kentucky Community Choir will perform. There will be games

and activities for the entire family, and all food and drinks will be free to the public. There will also be merchandise vendors and service providers.

The theme is **Unity in the Community** and is undergirded by the Biblical Scripture (Psalm 133:1), "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for Brothers and Sisters to dwell together in Unity!"

The committee's vision is to use this event as an opportunity for the citizens, leaders, authority figures, employers and service providers of the Northern Kentucky/Greater Cincinnati Community to unite and celebrate in the spirit of Unity in the Community!

Our goal is to educate, celebrate, connect, and collaborate with service providers to identify and address community needs. We would love to partner with your organization to provide individuals and families with civic information, education and employment opportunities, mental and physical health awareness, and the necessary skills and knowledge needed to empower them to be productive members of society. To do this, we need you!
