**Facilities, Transportation, and Safe Schools**

**Safety:**

- The Kentucky Center for School Safety will be with us on June 1 to attend our end of the year administrative retreat. All district and school level administrators will be trained in Threat Assessment and the KCSS team will help us create our parent communication and reunification plan.
- Mobilcomm has finished their installation of the radio repeaters. All schools now have new radios for internal and emergency communication. All school level administrators and appropriate district level staff have the ability to communicate districtwide in the event of an emergency.
- Since the last board meeting, I have met with the safety committees from NIS and NPS. At these meetings we discussed any available reports and any concerns that are present. As well, we discussed future proactive areas to address.
- We are going to be doing a planned power outage at NIS over Spring Break to test the generator and address any issues that we may discover.
- Ms. Stewart and I will be attending a KCSS/Secret Service training on April 25.
- I will be meeting with a fence company to enclose the courtyard at NHS. This was a safety recommendation per the KCSS Assessment. Also, as a part of their recommendations we will be installing bollards at the front entrance of NHS and by the cafeteria doors to deter anyone from driving a vehicle into the building.

- Phase 1 of the Athletic Complex is still on pace. Several meetings have occurred in preparation for the new bleachers and press box. By the next Board meeting I will hopefully have more information pertaining to the demolition of the current structure.
- The steam boiler at the Welcome Center continues to be an on-going maintenance issue. We will continue to do our best to keep it operational however that is why one of our upcoming projects is the Welcome Center HVAC replacement.

- Current projects in early phases: NPS Roof, Athletic Complex, NHS Culinary Arts, and Welcome Center HVAC.
- I am currently working on the facilities and transportation budgets for 23-24.

Transportation:

- The new camera systems have been installed on our buses. The video and sound quality is quite impressive. Since the installation of the cameras, we have had three instances of drivers running our stop signs. We are currently working with the Prosecutor to establish a procedure for when this occurs.
