Abby Keith – National Merit Scholarship Finalist

The National Merit Scholarship Program is an academic competition for recognition and scholarships that began in 1955. Approximately 1.5 million high school students enter the program each year. Of the 1.5 million entrants, some 50,000 with the highest PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index scores qualify for recognition in the program. In September, these high scorers are notified through their schools that they have qualified as either Commended Students or Semifinalists. 16,000 students are notified that they have qualified as Semifinalists. In February, 15,000 semifinalists are notified that they have advanced to finalist standing and receive a Certificate of Merit.

Abby Keith has accomplished each of these milestones and has been named a National Merit Scholarship Finalist.
