MUNICIPAL ORDER 16-2023

A MUNICIPAL ORDER REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY MUNICIPAL ORDER 15-2023 AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OWENSBORO AND ELLIS ENTERTAINMENT, LLC.

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2023, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Owensboro approved Municipal Order 15-2023 authorizing and directing the Mayor to execute a First Amendment to Agreement between the City of Owensboro and Ellis Entertainment, LLC by which the company was required to meet certain payroll requirements in order to earn the incentive provided for in the parties' Agreement dated April 20, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE CITY OF OWENSBORO, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Owensboro, Kentucky, by and through its Board of Commissioners, hereby repeals Municipal Order 15-2023, which authorized and directed the Mayor to execute a First Amendment to Agreement between the City of Owensboro and Ellis Entertainment, LLC by which the company was required to meet certain payroll requirements in order to earn the incentive provided for in the parties' Agreement dated April 20, 2022. The original Agreement with Ellis Entertainment, LLC as approved by Municipal Order 13-2022 remains in effect.

Section 2. That the Mayor, City Manager, and other City staff as appropriate are hereby authorized and directed to execute any other documents in furtherance thereof.
