#### **HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

This is the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) change order for the Ryland Heights Addition and Renovation Project associated with Century Construction. The original contract was \$4,368,195.00. This change order for an additional \$72,265.50 with previous change orders totaling \$63,875.22 makes the new contract sum \$4,504,335.72.

- Item No 1: Cost of Elevator from ThyssenKrupp Elevator Manufacturing PO #22003677. ADD: \$ 27,865.24
- Item No 2: Remove existing bar joists (not installed in location per original drawings) and stud/6" wall down to top of existing cmu wall to allow for installation of new 8" cmu classroom demising walls.

ADD: \$ 23,953.79

- Item No 3: Add steps to new concrete sidewalk at rear of the school due to existing grade.

  ADD: \$ 1,068.95
- Item No 4: Repair electrical conduit concealed in existing kitchen slab cut during slab sawcutting of slab for new underslab plumbing.

ADD: \$ 5,582.40

Item No 5: Replace carpet in four (4) first floor classrooms with MCT and new base to match adjacent remodeled corridor and new second floor classrooms.

ADD: \$ 13,795.12

Add cost of elevator material to General Contractor's contract and add a battery for lowering of elevator during emergencies. Full original cost of elevator material is being credited frrom the vendor's Direct Purchase Order

Cost Benefit to Owner: Vendor would not begin fabrication of the elevator without a 50% downpayment thereby conflicting with School Board policies

Remove existing bar joists (not installed in locatoin per original drawings) and stud/6" cmu wall down to top of existing cmu wall to allow for installation of new 8" cmu classroom demising walls

ADD: (12) days to schedule

Item No. 07-03 (PCO 42)

Add steps to new concrete sidewalk at rear of the school due existing grade Cost Benefit to Owner: Steps provided in lieu of an undesireable sloped sidewalk

ADD: \$1,068.95

Item No. 07-04 (PCO 49)

Repair electrical conduit concealed in existing kitchen slab cut during slab sawcutting of slab for new underslab plumbing. Cost Benefit to Owner: Repair of electric was required to restore to the affected areas of the school

ADD: \$5,582.40

Item No. 07-05 (PCO 50)

Replace carpet in four first floor classrooms with MCT and new base to match adjacent remodeled corridor and new second

Deduct removal of modular classroom foundations due to classrooms remaining in place

Cost Benefit to Owner: Existing carpet was near it's useful life expectancy. The MCT provides a more hygenic floor surface and will match the adjacent renovated area.

ADD: \$13,795.12
