Before an incident:

What can we do now to prevent or minimize the chance of an event?

- Promote the STOP tipline.
 - Make schools more aware of the program.
- Improve intervention rate.
 - Respond to at-risk behaviors and reports.
- Support gun control legislation.
 - Require mental health evaluations before purchasing a firearm.





During an incident:

What can we do to ensure the best response when an event happens?

- Active shooter drills.
- Improve training for first responders.
- Establish a clear notification system.





After an incident:

If/when the next school shooting happens in Kentucky, how do we prepare to support that community?

- Provide mental health support.
- Host town-hall style meetings.
- Repair and rebuild the school building.
