There have not been any changes in the head coaching positions since the last athletic report.

Sports Information:

The boys basketball team finished their season with an 22-9 record. They won the 6<sup>th</sup> District Tournament with a win over Webster County. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> Region Tournament, we opened up with a win over Trigg County in the first round but lost in the second round to Hopkinsville.

The girls basketball team finished 28-5. They won the 6<sup>th</sup> District with a win over Webster County and 2<sup>nd</sup> Region Tournament with wins over Madisonville, Christian County and Crittenden County. At the KHSAA State Tournament, they had wins over Simon Kenton and Louisville Mercy. They eventually lost to McCracken County in the third (semifinal) round,.

The dance team competed in the Pom and Game Day divisions at Nationals in Orlando, FL. They were crowned National Champions of the Pom division.

The baseball team is currently 5-8 with wins over Madisonville, Apollo, Owensboro, Grayson County and Franklin County.

The softball team is currently 12-2 and ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in the RPI with quality wins over Louisville Mercy, Madisonville, Butler County and Anderson County.

The boys tennis team is currently 7-1 and the girls team is 4-4.

The girls track team finished in 1<sup>st</sup> place at our own Colonel Classic and tied for 1<sup>st</sup> at the Muhlenberg March Madness track meet. The boys team finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> place at both of those meets. Imarie Carter won the Patty Posy Mitchell award for best female athlete at the Colonel Classic. At the indoor state meet, Imarie Carter finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in long jump while Hayden Tichenor finished 8<sup>th</sup>. Jaheim Williams finished 6<sup>th</sup> in the 60 yard dash and 9<sup>th</sup> in the 200 yard dash. In shot put, Hadley Wolfe finished 7<sup>th</sup> and Haden Wolfe finished 9<sup>th</sup>.
