- 2. Prices must be stated in units of quantity as specified and extended in total column for each item and/or lot. Bid prices must include transportation and delivery to the each building as specified.
- 3. To receive consideration, bids must be received prior to time designated in this notice. None shall be accepted thereafter.
- 4. The Board of Education (The Board) reserves the right to waive defects and informalities in proposals, to reject any or all proposals, or to accept any proposal as may be deemed to its interest, and to award by item, combination of items or lot.
- 5. Manufacturer's catalog numbers, trade names, etc., where shown herein, are for descriptive purposes to guide the Bidder in interpreting the standard of quality, design and performance desired, and shall not be construed to exclude proposals based on furnishing other types of materials or service. However, any substitution or departure proposed by Bidder must be clearly noted and described, otherwise it is understood that Bidder intends to supply items specifically mentioned in the bid notification.
- 6. Samples requested must be furnished free of expense to The Board. If not destroyed or consumed in testing or evaluating, or required in connection with the award, samples shall upon request be returned at the Bidder's expense. Right is reserved to mutilate or destroy any samples if considered necessary for testing purposes.
- 7. If awarded an order or contract, Bidder agrees to protect, defend and save harmless The Board from suits or demands for payment that may be brought against it for the use of any patented materials, process, article or device that may enter into the manufacture, construction or form a part of the work covered by either order or contract. Bidder further agrees to indemnify and save harmless The Board from suits or actions of every nature and description brought against it for, or on account of injuries or damages received or sustained by any party or parties by, or for any acts of the contractor, his servants or agents.
- 8. The Board does not pay federal excise taxes or Kentucky Sales and Use Taxes. Proposals should be priced accordingly and reflect no sales tax to MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS.
- 9. Contractors remain liable for applicable taxes on construction and/or furnish-and-install contracts for Mercer County Public Schools (MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS). Adjustments and allowances for any applicable taxes shall be provided for in the bid amount. No later adjustments to the Contract Sum shall be permitted and/or made on this basis by MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS.
- 10. Except as otherwise provided in this agreement, parties to this agreement are solely responsible for costs incurred in fulfilling obligations under this agreement. No party shall have any claim against the other party for reimbursement of such costs, unless said costs are attributable to

- enforcing compliance under this agreement or seeking redress from the other party's default under this agreement.
- 11. If any section, paragraph or clause of this contract is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of said section, paragraph or clause shall not affect any remaining provisions herein.
- 12. This contract is made under, governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- 13. Venue for any legal action filed concerning this contract is Mercer County, Kentucky.
- 14. Parties shall not discriminate in any of the services performed in connection with this contract on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, creed, political affiliation, marital status, sex or disabling condition.

- 1. This Bid is for a seating packages at Mercer County Intermediate School, items can be bid separately. For further specific information please contact Chris Minor, Food Services Director, at 859-733-7211.
- 2. Bids must be delivered to MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS Board of Education, 530 Perryville St., Harrodsburg KY 40330. Bids may be returned by United States Postal Service, hand delivered or by any commercial carrier. It is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure the Bids arrives by the date and time of the opening. **E-mail, fax or telephone Bids shall not be accepted. There are no exceptions.**

Bids shall close on Wednesday, April 19, at 9:30AM LOCAL TIME

- 3. Bidders are to not telephone for tabulation. MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS staff provides written notification following awards by The Board.
- 4. The Board reserves the right to waive defects and informalities in proposals, to reject any or all proposals, or to accept any proposal as may be deemed to its interest, and to award by item, combination of items or lot.
- 5. Prices quoted must have the decimal point located in the correct position to separate dollars from cents. In bid prices where the decimal point is omitted, the bid prices shall be calculated as dollar amounts.
- 6. Prices quoted must include transportation, delivery to the location specified on each purchase order.
- 7. Price quoted includes storage of goods if needed
- 8. Erasures or the use of typewriter correction fluid on bid forms are not acceptable and may result in the rejection of the bid. Prior to submission or openings, errors may be crossed out, corrections entered, and initialed by the person signing the bid. No bids shall be altered or amended after the specified time of opening.
- 9. Modifications, additions or changes to the terms and conditions of this notice to bid may be a cause for rejection of a bid. Bidders are to submit all bids on the forms supplied with this notice. submitted on company forms may be rejected.

- 12. MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS reserves the right to cancel contract if in the staff's opinion the contractor's work is unsatisfactory, his ability to meet completion schedules is unsatisfactory or billing is found to be excessive for work performed.
- 13. MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS may terminate the contract if the contractor fails to perform at the level specified in the contract document. Contractor may terminate the contract if MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS fails to meet the specified payment terms.

Each party shall follow the procedure outlined below, if a contract is to be terminated:

- Step 1 Issue warning letter and outline violations and length of time to correct the problem.
- Step 2 Issue letter of Intent to Cancel Contract, if problem is not resolved by given date.
- Step 3 Issue letter which cancels contract
- 14. The successful Bidder shall make provision for the supplying of purchase order numbers as a part of any invoice issued to MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS as a result of being awarded this bid.
- 15. MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS allocation and accounting system may require the issuance of more than one Purchase Order (PO) for the materials in a bid/Item and a separate invoice is required for each PO.
- 16. Payments for bid items are normally approved at the regularly scheduled meeting of The Board on the second Tuesday of most months, provided the bid items and invoices are properly received by the first Monday of the month. However, payments may be made early to take advantage of cash discounts offered, provided the taking of such discounts is advantageous to MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS.
- 17. If MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS staff need to place a toll or long distance telephone call regarding complaints, adjustments, shortages, failure to deliver, etc., in connection with this contract, the vendor shall bear expense for all calls.
- 18. If a quotation is not made, the bid form must be marked "No RFP" and returned with reasons stated why a RFP was not submitted. Otherwise, Bidder's name may be removed from the official mailing roster.
- 19. Bidders are invited to attend the bid opening and requested to not telephone for a tabulation. Written notification shall be provided following awards by The Board.
- 20. Successful vendors shall provide two copies of Materials Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) on material covered by OSHA Standard 1910.1200 as a condition of purchase.
- 21. The consumption of alcohol or drugs or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs, use of any tobacco products or possession of firearms, while on a job for MERCER COUNTY SCHOOLS by any worker is strictly prohibited. Any contractor, subcontractor or person working for the contractor or subcontractor who violates rules regarding alcohol, drugs, tobacco products or firearms, is subject to immediate removal from the job site.
