Opening Business

- a. Approval of the Agenda
 - a. Motion to approve by Mr. Fitzgerald, second by Ms. Sparks. No objections.
- b. Approval of the February Minutes
 - a. Motion to approve by Mrs. Kohrs, second by Mr. Fitzgerald. No objections.
- c. Good News Report
 - a. All juniors took the ACT earlier this month. Students were treated to a breakfast by Chef Pam.
 - b. 38 sophomores and seniors also took an optional ACT earlier this month.
 - c. 32 sophomores toured Gateway's campus and heard about their course/program offerings earlier this month.
 - d. FBLA regional competition-8 high school and 3 middle school awards.
 - e. Charlie and the Chocolate Factory was put on by the drama club this past weekend and was considered wildly successful.
 - f. The Dayton Street Meet was yesterday. Mr. Herbst and his volunteers worked very hard to put on a unique event.
- d. Public Comment
 - a. No public present for comment.
 - i. Ms. Sparks noted that the SBDM section of the school website needs to be updated.

Student Achievement Report/Data

- a. Honor Roll/Super Honor Roll Report
 - a. Both of the honor roll and super honor roll were shared for informational purposes. Mr. Meyers noted a 3rd quarter drop in super honor roll, otherwise he considered numbers to be consistent.
- b. Postsecondary Readiness Report
 - a. Currently 42/59=71%. 9 more students have a realistic chance of becoming postsecondary ready.
- c. Graduation Update
 - a. A graduate tracking meeting occurred last week.

Budget Report

- a. Mr. Meyers noted that this month's budget report was generated by the district office and appears different. Mr. Meyers noted the request from the prom committee regarding a potential \$1,000 donation. Discussion amongst council on the merits of the donation and whether it was tied to academic achievement or not.
 - a. Motion to accept an amended budget reflecting a \$1,000 donation to prom motioned for by Mr. Sumpter, second by Mr. Fitzgerald. No objections.

Committee Reports

- a. English Department
 - a. Mr. Fitzgerald shared STAR data from the Fall and Winter. Areas of note:
 - i. Growth in percentile rankings in 8th, 10th, and 11th grades.
 - ii. Every grade showed growth.
 - iii. Concern: 55% of 11th grade students scored below proficiency.
 - iv. Concern: 18.3% scored at or above the 50th national percentile.

New Business

- a. Staffing Allocation Projections for 2023-2024 School Year
 - a. Mr. Meyers shared projected staff allocations for the 2023-24 school year.
- b. Discussion of Grading Policy
 - a. Mr. Meyers shared grading policy 23.02. Discussion regarding eliminating the summative/formative 60/40 grading split. Potential policy changes will be followed-up during PLCs.
