Recommendation/Motion: I move that the topic of learning for the May 18, 2023 Team of Six training is on the Board's Self Evaluation.

Background/Rationale: The performance of individual board members is evaluated periodically by the voters at the ballot box, but rarely is the entire board's performance evaluated unless the board intentionally makes that happen. A board self-evaluation is a method for a board of education to assess whether the board is meeting expectations, making progress toward goals, and a chance to gather feedback on the board's health. The self-evaluation provides self-accountability, a framework for communication and it lays the foundation for the board's continuous improvement. The FCPS committed to completing an annual self-evaluation in its Governance Manual but has not yet to be trained as to how to successfully begin and complete the process
