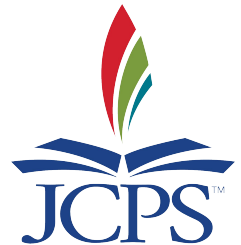
Two Approaches

- Board Approval





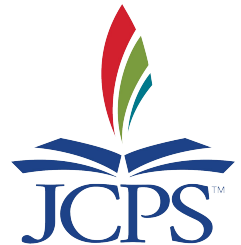

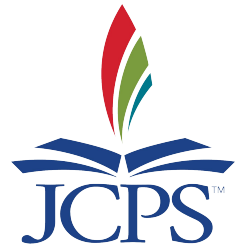

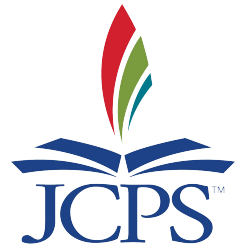
New SSBH Website with Elementary and MS/HS friendly language

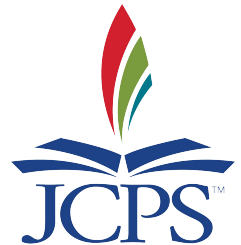

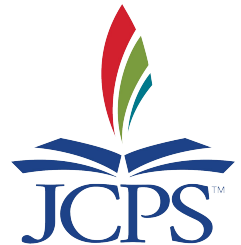

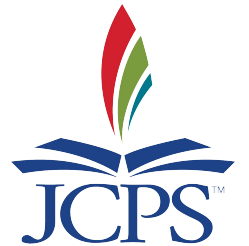
Extended option for bus suspension lengths

- District level oversight and approval



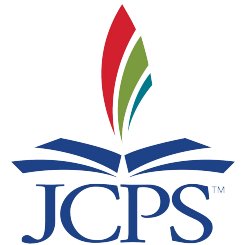
