- Lincoln students have completed their **Spring STAR testing** and **Spring AIMSweb** testing in the subjects of Reading and Math. We look forward to sharing this student growth data with you soon.
- Our **fifth and final Family Engagement Day** of this school year will be held here at Lincoln on Tuesday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. We will be focusing on our students' strengths, summer goals, and administering a brief "customer service" questionnaire.
