




Counselor Position Re:

Currently all schools are being serviced equally in terms of staffing for school counselors at all high schools. Based on a detailed needs assessment below, the following data indicates a need for increased support and resources at this school. The creation of this position will allow the school counselors to spend more time with students for social and emotional support, future planning, etc. instead of administrative duties with only two assistant principals and testing responsibilities that consume a high school all year long which can be viewed HERE.

North Bullitt High School:

Mental Health is consistently a concern of our school. In addition to support from a district
therapist we are also partnered with LaCorgan Counseling, Transformations, and Seven Counties
Services. At this time we have 6 students on the waiting list for therapy services.

- Responsibilities of our 2 counselors include testing, master scheduling, PSPs, 504s, enrollment-transcripts, schedule requests, new student onboarding, credit monitoring, Bark responses, Best Fit, Naviance, dual credit coordinators, points of contact for students, parents, and outside agencies, GSP, Infinite Campus grades/report cards, UPS, work release, management of early graduation.
- With the addition of predictive assessments to the high school assessment load this school year BAC responsibilities pull at least one counselor away from their other duties monthly. Our 2 counselors are responsible for the following in regard to assessment- test training (admin code and test specific), Benchmark assessments 3 times annually, On Demand Practice 2 times annually, Civics Testing, Access Testing, ACT, AP Testing, and KSA. In addition to monitoring these assessments our counselors must also plan for a growing number of students with 504 and IEP accommodations.
