EVACUATION SITE AGREEMENT between CAMPBELLSVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS and TIM HORTON CHILDREN'S FOUNDATION, US. INC (TIM HORTON CAMP KENTAHTEN)

Whereas, an emergency that occurs on the property of Tim Horton Camp Kentahnten may require the evacuation of the all or part of the camp population. This may be the result of a number of situations:

1. Prolonged Power Failure
2. Fire
3. Propane or natural gas leak
4. Severe Weather; or
5. By the order of governmental officials

Whereas, the Camp Senior Manager, in consultation with the Director of Camp Operations and/or President and Executive Director will make the decision to evacuate if a situation occurs.

Whereas, in each situation, Tim Horton Camp Kentahnten shall arrange for the camp population, regardless of size to be moved to an offsite location.

Whereas, the Camp Senior Manager shall update an agreement annually with the offsite location to ensure their site is still available.

Therefore, the Campbellsville Independent Schools Board of Education has agreed to allow the two below sites serve as evacuation points for the Tim Horton Camp Kentahnten:
