Meeting Minutes

- **Call to Order**

Chair Snipes welcomed everyone and called the KBE Special Committee-Student Learning Experiences, Session Three meeting to order at 10:00am. Chair Snipes stated she is excited to have everyone in attendance today at the third and final session of this special committee meeting.

- **Roll Call**

- **Discussion**

Chair Snipes opened the meeting by diving right into the results of the survey results of the submission on draft value statements. This committee survey was given to members last week as pre-work materials. The purpose of this special committee is to now finalize a set of value statements around learning experiences that we hope to promote and endorse moving forward as we transform the learning experiences here in Kentucky. Thank you to our KBE members who expressed interest in forming these workgroups.

Patrice McCrary, Holly Bloodworth, and JoAnn Adams members of the committee who are part of the Kentucky Board of Education began the conversations by discussing their thoughts and what they have learned from being on this special committee. Chair Snipes recapped the information received from the survey that this committee completed and began the discussion to the overall draft value statements that have come from this special committee. Today, Chair Snipes wants the committee to concentrate this time on narrowing the nineteen statements and narrow those down to five statements.

Chair Snipes requested the members of this committee divide into a few small break-out groups for about 25 minutes to identify the potential overlaps, gaps, and areas of improvement in the small groups to then condensed proposal to bring forward from this special committee on forward to the members of the Kentucky Board of Education.

- **Next Steps**

Chair Snipes closed the meeting by stating that the committee was able to narrow the nineteen statements down to about seven draft value statements that we can play with as we go forward. Thank you all for your willingness to engage a little bit more offline

past this third session. Chair Snipes felt really good about all the discussion today and she really appreciates the thoughtfulness and intention around not limiting ourselves too much so that we don't lose sight of the things that we really want to lift up and value and send a strong signal in consideration to the full members of the Kentucky Board of Education as they work through the call to action moving forward. Chair Snipes will be sending the special committee members a follow up email to finalize the action.
