The tennis team wrapped up their season by sending one girls doubles team (Merrick Conkright and Cameron Chandler), one boys doubles team (Thomas Berger and Alton Berger) and two boys singles players (Mason Bridgeman and Jaxton Duncan) to compete in the KHSAA State Tennis Tournament.

The track team sent 14 kids in 12 events to the KHSAA State 3A Track Meet. Top 10 finishers included Bryce Tapp placed 2nd in discus, Jaheim Williams was 6th in the 200 m dash, Imarie Carter was 8th in the triple jump, Hadley Wolfe was 9th in shot put, and Haden Wolfe was 10th in discus.

The bass fishing team sent two boys (Jessie Ligon and Hayden Stevens) to the state tournament.

The baseball team finished the regular season with a 14-17 record, but beat Union County for the 6th District Championship and Caldwell County, Lyon County and Christian County on the way to the 2nd Region Championship. They beat Pulaski County and Harrison County in the first two rounds of the KHSAA State Baseball Tournament. They are currently 20-17 and playing in the semifinals of the state tournament on Friday, June 9.

The softball team finished the regular season with a 26-5 record. They claimed the 6th District Tournament with a win over Union County and the 2nd Region Tournament with wins over Fort Campbell, Madisonville North Hopkins and Caldwell County. They beat Great Crossing and Central Hardin in the first two rounds of the KHSAA State Softball Tournament. They will play East Jessamine in the semifinals of the state tournament on Friday, June 9.
