Fiscal/Budgetary Impact:

The End of Year (EOY) average daily attendance (ADA) will determine the district budget for 2022-2023. House Bill 1 passed by the Kentucky Legislature in August (2022 special session) has a provision for flood-impacted school districts that states if ADA for SY 2022-2023 decreases by 3% or more than ADA from SY 2018-2019, the ADA for calculation of SEEK paid during SY 2023-2024 shall be increased by 2/3 of the decrease.

History/Background:


The 9th and final attendance month ended with the last day of school (month 10 is all disaster days this year). The 2022-2023 school year has been a challenging one for school attendance as the return to normal that we expected to see in school attendance did not happen this year. When planning for 2023-24, schools must look at key dates (such as the last days of school) as many of these were much lower than normal. In the final two weeks of school, there was only one day where attendance for the district was higher than the end of year average of 88.94%.


