## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Content PLC's and grade levels of teachers have been coming/will be coming in for curriculum work this summer. So far these grade levels/content areas have been in:
  - LES Intermediate Math, Intermediate Science/SS, Special Area (Media/Library, Health/PE, Unified Arts), Kindergarten and First grade
  - o DHS HS Business
  - o All other groups are scheduled to come in during the month of July or August.
  - o LES Reviewing the Scope and Sequence of the new Amplify Reading Series.
  - DHS Building students background knowledge through the use of vocabulary. Also, teaching the six steps process for teaching vocabulary; intentionally looking at what vocabulary is taught at each grade level and within each content, determining where vocabulary will be taught throughout the school year.
- During these curriculum days, teachers are ensuring there is a completed Curriculum Timeline
  for the upcoming school year, a Unit Organizer for each unit on their curriculum timeline, a
  Pacing Guide for each unit on their curriculum timeline, and they are uploading assessments and
