- 7. Provide some interventions and supports

- 9. Assist with lesson planning
- 10. Assist students and families with goal setting
- 11. Assist with administering benchmark assessments (or other assessments as necessary)
- 12. Evaluates pupils' academic and social growth, keeps appropriate records, and prepares progress reports.
- 13. Identifies pupil's needs and cooperates with other professional staff members in assessing and helping pupils solve health, attitude and learning problems, including but not limited to development and implementation of Section 504 Plans, Individual Education Plans (IEP) and Gifted Student Service Plans (GSSP). Maintains competence through professional growth activities as identified by individual or school needs.
