

University of Kentucky Team Soccer Camp

This yearly camp is hosted by the University of Kentucky on their campus. Teams from across the state come to participate in a 4-day camp where players and coaches can stay on campus as a team.

The goal is to give players the ability to learn from coaches from collegiate teams, give them an environment to build team chemistry, exposure to teams from other parts of the state, and the ability to talk to coaches to help them continue their post-secondary career.

The camp dates are July 10th, 11th, 12th, and 13th returning home after camp on the 13th.

Cost of the camp will be covered by PCHS Boys Soccer funds that we have, and continue to, raise by fundraising along with a donation by Peoples Exchange Bank.

Food and lodging will be covered by the camp fee (\$400 per student). Players can bring extra money for food or items outside of the provided meals.

Day 1 July 10th: Arrival and check in to the University of Kentucky campus. Begin instruction with college coaches. One game will be played in the afternoon. Dinner will be provided.

Day 2 July 11th: Another day of instruction and lectures. One game in the afternoon, breakfast, lunch, and dinner will be provided.

Day 3 July 12th: Continued instruction and recovery session. One game in the afternoon with breakfast, lunch and dinner provided.

Day 4 July 13th: Breakfast in the morning followed by the last game of the camp, checkout and return home that afternoon.

We are requesting a bus driver to take us and drop us off at the camp and come back and pick us up on the fourth day.

Cost analysis for bus driver:

\$1 per mile @ 180 miles = \$180

\$20 per hour X 4 hours = \$80

Total Cost: \$260
