Board Report
Wednesday, June 21st, 2023



- High School Curriculum work for the 2023-2024 school years has begun.
- Graduation Rate for the Class of 2023:
 - 56/59 – 94.9%
- Post-Secondary Ready Rate for Class of 2023:
 - 44/56 – 78.57%
- 739 Dual College Credit hours earned school year by our sophomores/juniors/seniors.
 - Includes YSA, Gateway, ATC, and Skilled Trades.
- YSA Update:
 - Total Courses Completed in Spring of 2023 – 64
 - Number of A's Earned in Spring of 2023 – 37
 - Average Term GPA: 2.967
 - Average Cumulative GPA: 3.206
- Final Grades for the 4th Quarter/2nd Semester must be posted by Tuesday, May 30th @ 11:00 a.m.
 - Report Cards may be picked up on Friday, June 2nd
- Summer School Update (Last day is Friday, June 23rd):
 - High School – 41 Students
 - 23/41 Students Attended Summer School
 - Each student who no showed was called directly and asked to attend – impact and consequences of not coming to summer school to earn credits back were shared.
 - 15 Total Credits Earned
 - 10 Students still working on credits as of Tuesday, June 20th.



- Middle School – 23 Students
 - 20/23 Students Attended Summer School
 - 48 Total Classes were needed by students.
 - 12 Students have completed all summer school requirements.
 - 3 Students are currently still working.
 - 8 Students have not/will not complete summer school credits and will be required to finish course work when school resumes in August.
- Athletic Report:
 - This year we had 50 Academic All-Stars in the High School. Several Middle School students participated in High School sports, but they were not included in grade calculations or the number would probably be higher.
 - 16 athletes received Honorable Mention
 - 34 athletes received 1st Team
 - We had 21 Triple Threat Athletes and an additional 4 students who participated in 3 or more sports but did not qualify for the Triple Threat Award. Of our Triple Threat Athletes, 6 are 1st Team Academic All Stars as are all 4 students mentioned above and 5 received Honorable Mention.
- Track – Sent 4 Unified Athletes (Partnered with another athlete)
 - 1 Independent Athlete Competed in 200
 - Total of 9 athletes competed at State Competition in Lexington
 - Events Included – Sprint Relays, Long Jump, Shot Put, 200 Meter Dash
- Dayton High School had the 2nd most triple-threat athletes in the State of Kentucky this school year.
