Bullitt County Public Schools was selected during the 2022-2023 school year to participate in the Algebra 1 Micro-Credentialing Pilot program in collaboration with the Kentucky Department of Education. The purpose of this pilot is to create, test, and give feedback on innovative assessment strategies in movement towards changes to our state assessment system. - Considerations:
 - Resource vetted using the HQIR rubric
 - Materials purchased to support innovative classroom environment
 - Professional learning in support of new math resources
