Ending GF Cash Balance: o \$ 8.42 million as opposed to \$6.77 million last year at the same time. General Fund Revenue: o Overall revenue was up 9% compared to the prior year at the same time. o Receipts received in the year were 10% higher as opposed to the prior year at the same time. o The district has received 98.7% of the revenue budgeted for the year at 92% through the fiscal year. Suggests the district will receive more than what was budgeted. General Fund Expenditures: o Up 6% compared to the prior year at the same time. o Expenses of \$1.7 million in May. o The district has expended and encumbered 81.1% of the expenses budgeted for the year at 92% through the fiscal year. Suggests the district will expend less than what was budgeted.
