<b>Positive Developments and Highlights</b>	<p>This was our second year using Universal Tennis Rating (UTR) to enable year-round match reporting of results for all member schools. We encountered very few issues during the course of the season, as our coaches are becoming more and more familiar with the platform.</p>
<b>Championship Update/Review</b>	<p>The event ran smoothly on the courts. The time schedule was adjusted in the planning process so that an official could chair each semifinal match (as opposed to just the finals) and that was met with positive feedback.</p> <p>There were concerns raised by spectators at both venues about some of the parking challenges they encountered, but maps were provided online to display the parking areas available for fans. That information was also included in the postseason instructions and covered in the pre-event conference call with coaches and administrators.</p>
<b>Officials Update/Review</b>	<p>We once again worked with the Kentucky Tennis Umpires Association to assign officials for the tournament. We thank them for their hard work and dedication to the success of the event.</p>
