Logan County High School request to be able to move to Class 2A Region 1, instead of the proposed Class 2A Region 2.

We feel it would benefit the athletes in our school on and off the course and track. We were previously in 2A Region 2 and had great relationships with those schools. Many of the schools listed in 2A Region 2 are located in the Eastern Time Zone and would cause our students to leave school extremely early to travel to their sites for regular season meets or if they held regionals at one of those schools.

We feel if this move is approved that it would also benefit some of the teams in Region 2 by reducing the number of teams.
