- The markup doesn't look correct with 15% total allowed by the contract. Looks like 10% from AES and Calhoun? Typically I have seen subcontractor do 7.5% and GC at 7.5%. Adjusted CCS down to 5%.
- Additional lift costs are provided. There should already be a lift on site for the work under the pressbox to bring
 main power, fiber and misc conduits in for all the field accessories, scoreboard, etc. AES: Yes there is but it will
 need to be for longer, hence cost more money for rental.
- additional cost for network drip is indicated. The network drop count didn't change. AES: Deleted
- no credit is provided for all the labor and material for surface wiremold from each drop location (see pic of original drawings of scope removed) – AES provided

additional material deliver costs are indicated? AES/Calhoun to confirm no more deliveries to site are being provided and all materials already exist on site. If this is not the case, these material could easy come on an existing truck and there should be no material or fuel charge. – AES: Additional work material needs additional delivery. Reduced.


