Consider/Approve a building and grounds alteration request at Simon Kenton High for vinyl mesh window graphics to be installed on gym doors and windows.

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

5.11 - Alterations of Buildings and Grounds

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Simon Kenton High School SBDM Council approved of a request from Athletic Director Troy Roberts to have BSN Athletics install vinyl mesh window graphics on the entry doors of the main and auxiliary gyms, as well as the Athletic Department office space. Installation of the window graphics will increase the aesthetics of the gym area, promote branding of SK Athletic Programs, and improve safety by reducing sightlines into the expansive gym areas from exterior areas. The SK Athletic program has earned sufficient reward dollars with BSN Athletics to cover the cost of the materials and installation of the graphics. Future upkeep of the window graphics will be paid by the SK Athletic Department. This request has been reviewed and approved for Board consideration by the District's Operations team.

- 5. GOOD NEWS REPORT- Mr. Reinhart reported Gabriella Ocasio received a bronze medal for girls wrestling in Mexico Tournament, which places her 3rd in the world. Ms. Lewis announced the dance team received three superiors (for dance), and they have 3 All Americans on the team. Ms. Browning reported the cheer team won most spirit and received "the banana" (spirit stick) during cheer camp in Indiana. Mr. Reinhart reported the school is fully staffed and welcomed new SBDM members.

- b. Pillar 2: Student Readiness- Nothing to report.
- c. Pillar 3: Engaged, Well Rounded Students- Mr. Reinhart reported AP testing scores have been released to students.
 - i. Supplemental Positions: Mr. Reinhart proposed a draft for Stipend Position Proposal Survey. The site-based budget allows eight full positions for such clubs, activities, and organization.

- f. Pillar 6: Fiscal and Operational Systems
 - i. Policy Binder Updates: Mr. Reinhart discussed creating an Adhoc to accommodate the New State Laws and recommended a committee to lead the initiative. Ms. Lewis motioned to approve and Ms. Browning seconded the motion.
