## Fundraising Activities for the FSHS Interact Club

Activity 1- Partnership with Rotary of Franklin KY, Contact Club Youth Service Chair, Robin Hollingsworth, 270-223-8092.

Rotary Club of Franklin KY and FSHS Interact Club are teaming up with Love the Hungry, Louisville, KY to fight hunger globally as an international community service project. The goal is to pack 10,000-20,000 nutrient-rich meals. Each meal will cost .35. The FSHS Interact Club will fundraise \$3,500 to \$7,000 depending on the agreed target number.

The event is scheduled for Spring 2024 with fundraising efforts starting as early as late August to early September. This is a great opportunity not only for our youth to raise the funds to meet the project goals but also to volunteer their time and energy to actually packaging the meals in a fun, high energy atmosphere with adult community members.

Phase 1 is fundraising across the community utilizing district marketing resources via prints, social media, and other virtual methods. A QR code will be created for marketing purposes with donations going directly to Simpson County Board of Education or Rotary Club of Franklin KY on behalf of the FSHS Interact Club Love the Hungry project.

Phase 2 is the event itself where the nutrient-rich meals are packaged by FSHS Interact Club members, Rotary Club of Franklin KY members, and volunteers from the Franklin-Simpson Community. The location of the event will be Franklin Simpson High School. Principal, Mr. Wix will determine the approved location for the setup of multiple packaging station. The equipment needed for the event is long tables to set up 5-8 packaging lines (10-16 tables). The number of volunteers and meals to package will determine the number of packaging lines needed.

Love the Hungry will supply everything else necessary to complete the project.

At the entrance of the school district on Wildcat Way (Iris St) a large sign will be displayed to track the progress of the fundraiser and promote awareness.

Letters promoting the event requesting donations will be mailed to the community at large.
