
Facilities Updates - Lebanon Elementary

Outdoor classrooms are in-progress with some nearing completion.






New teachers attended the MCPS New Teacher Academy to go over procedures for the upcoming school year.





Media Specialists attended a training for the Distance-Learning systems purchased through the RUS grant.






Teachers received training on the new ViewSonic boards -- nearly 120 boards have been installed across the district.

Marion County EMS used Marion County Middle School for an emergency management training on July 25 and 26.






