Recommendation/Motion: A motion is in order to approve the addition of the Healthy Schools Specialist position.

Background/Rationale: The recent global pandemic exposed a number of health-related issues that our students are experiencing, some issues were evident prior to the pandemic - others were the result of the global pandemic response. In light of issues facing students, staff have worked to develop a strategic plan using the Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) Whole Community, Whole School, Whole Child (WSCC) model for health. Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) shared that the CDC offered a grant program (School-Based Interventions to Promote Equity and Improve Health, Academic Achievement, and Well-Being of Students) to address health issues in school communities. FCPS was asked if there was interest in applying for grant funds in a joint effort to fund a student wellness initiatives based on the WSCC model, as Fayette already had a strategic plan, FCPS agreed to the proposal. KDE learned their proposal was approved in June. \$106,000 per year, for a period of 5 years has been pledged to FCPS as their portion of the funding package. Staff recommends funds used to fund a 10.5-month FTE position to assist in heading up a comprehensive school health team to address health barriers to education as outlined in the strategic plan.
