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8. NBCT Pilot Program Update

- a. SCMS held a celebration for their four NCBT Pilot Program Cohort members. This group is taking advantage of the state pilot that allows teachers with fewer than three years to be in the National Board Certified

Teacher process. It was a GREAT event that included three folks from KDE that had amazing interactions with the pilot group. This could be HUGE in supporting and keeping strong, young teachers receive Rank II pay quicker, cheaper, and *potentially* be more impactful in regard to effectiveness.
