- You have certain rights regarding the personal information and sensitive personal information that PLTW collects and processes. PLTW respects these rights:
 - To know what information is collected and processed, and why
 - To access your data
 - To ask for correction if the information we are processing is incomplete, incorrect or out-of-date
 - To ask us to delete information, such as information that is no longer relevant
 - To have a copy of the data to take to another service provider
 - To know what third parties we share data with.
- You also have the right to know the impact of these requests.
- PLTW has the policy of granting these requests when possible. However:

 - If the requested correction is factual, and PLTW does not agree that the correction is appropriate, PLTW may not be able to make the requested correction.
