Good afternoon,

Attached is the fundraiser approval request form for the 2023 HOCO Parade and Community Pep Rally.

I presented our idea to the Scottsville City Council last night, and we received an unanimous Yes vote to proceed as proposed.

The QBC's request for fundraiser approval attached is for the ability for the QBC to charge an entry fee for parade participants.

Our Proposal includes:

- Any Allen County School affiliated programs (i.e. sports, clubs, organizations, etc.) can participate for \$15.00 per entry.
- All NON-Allen County Schools affiliated programs (i.e. local businesses, churches, county officials, community organizations, fire departments, etc.) can participate for \$25.00 per entry.
- High School and Middle School football players, High School Cheerleaders, High School Band and this year's HOCO court candidates will not be charged an entry fee to participate.
- This year's Hall of Fame inductees will serve as the Grand Marshalls and lead the parade route from the start point to the High School – and will not be charged an entry fee.

After the parade, we will have a community Pep Rally located at the Football Stadium (weather permitting).

We are requesting to allow Food/Vendor Trucks to set up and sell food items, in which the QBC will received a percentage of the sales.

Please let me know if I need to provide any additional information to progress this request.

If we get full approval to proceed, the QBC will begin communicating the festivities, working along with the City of Scottsville and the Heart of Scottsville project.




