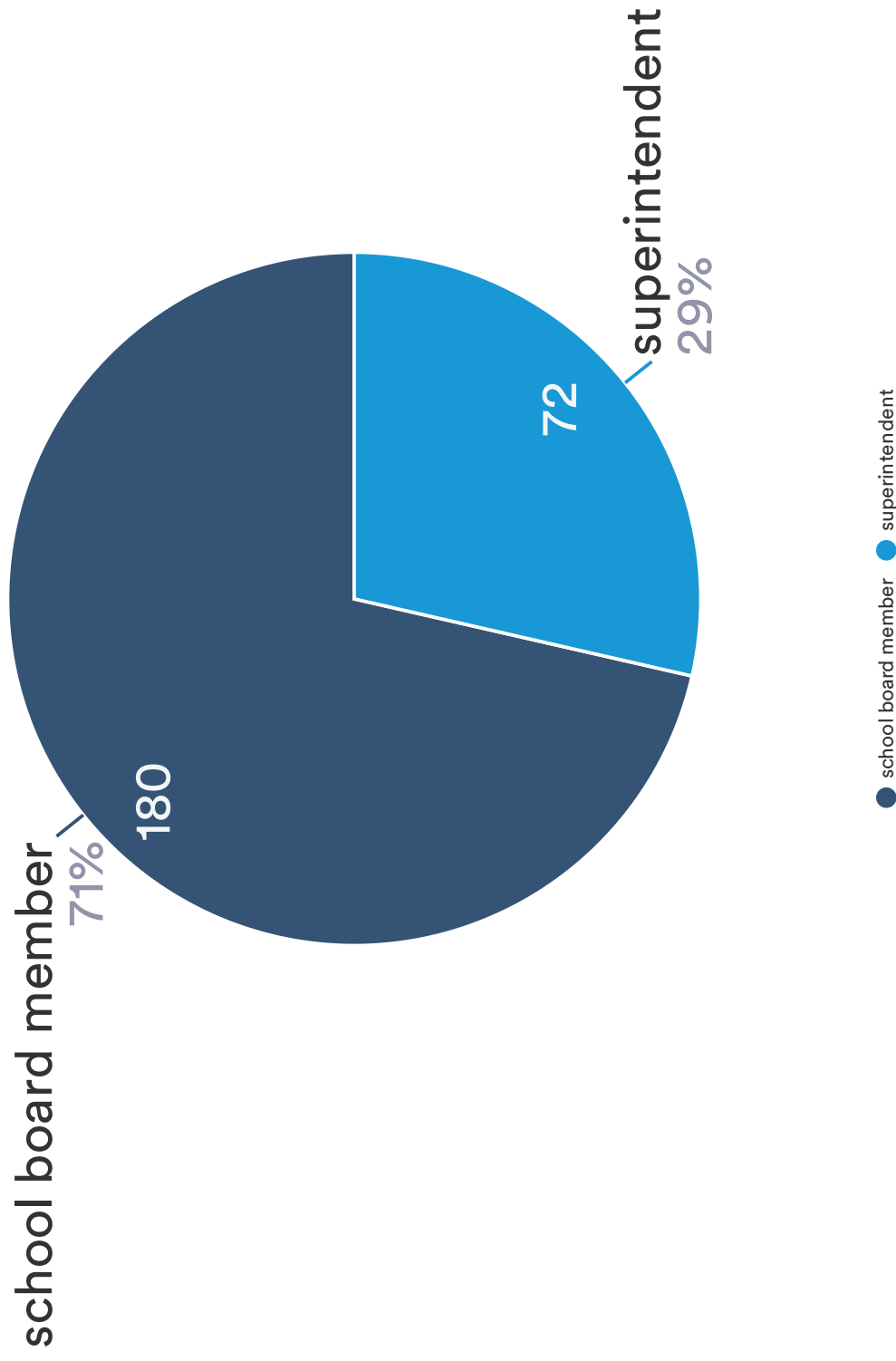
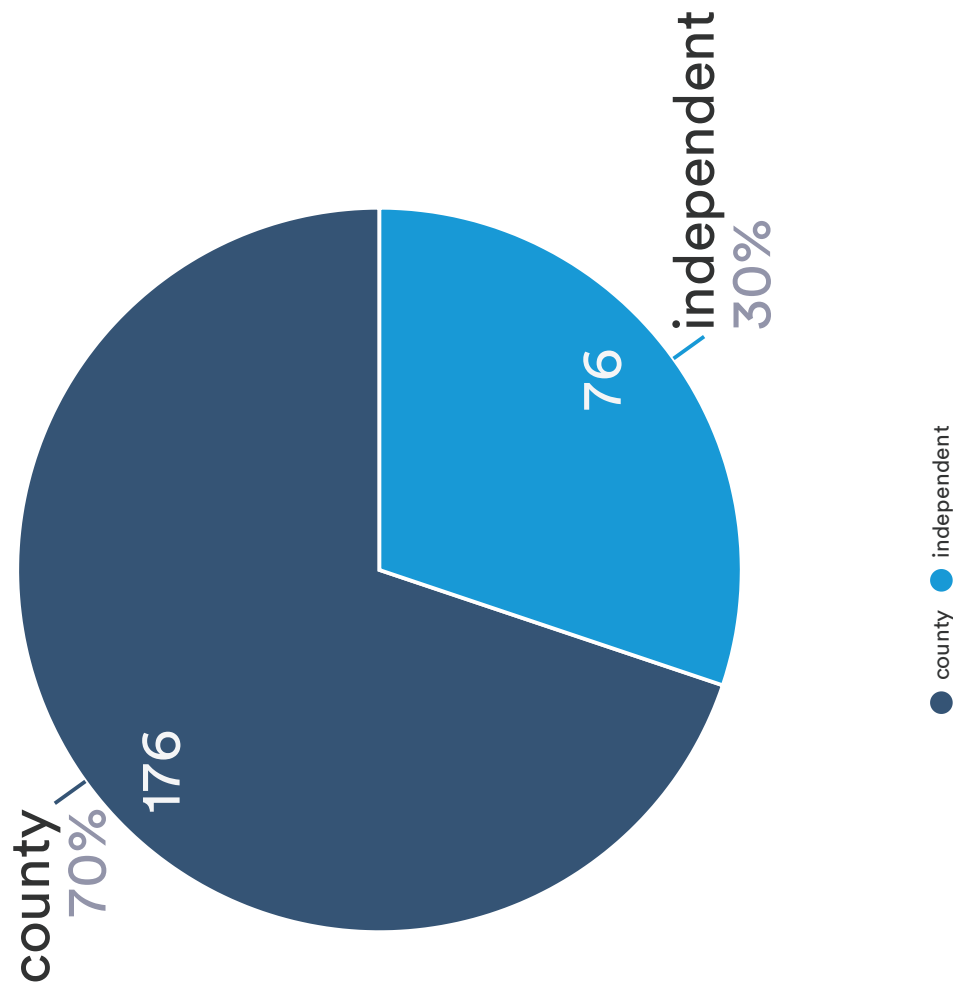

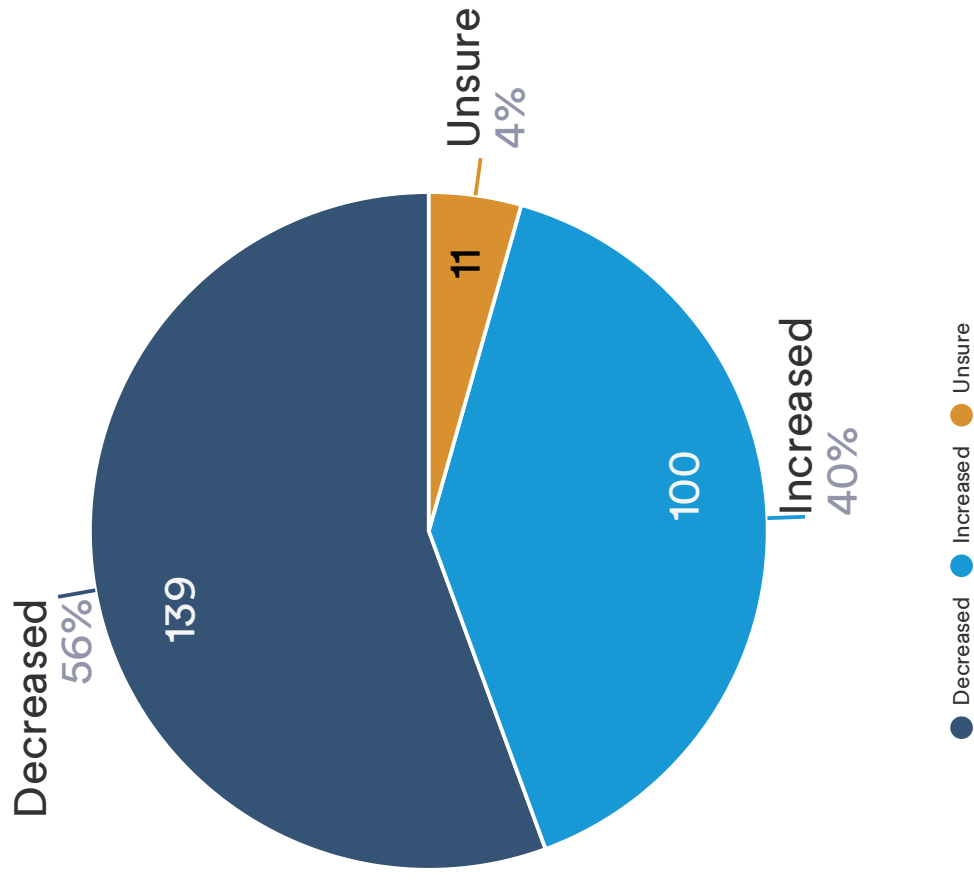
Do you represent a county or independent school district?

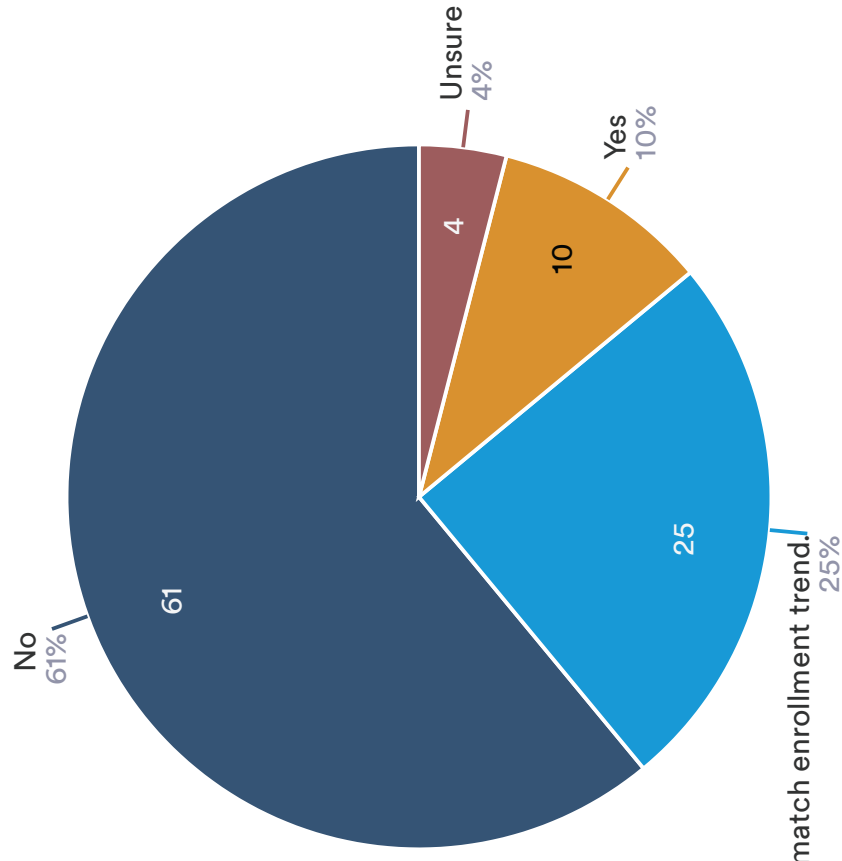
Over the last 2-3 years, has enrollment in your district increased or decreased?

Do you believe your board has received the necessary state and local funding increases to serve your increased enrollment?

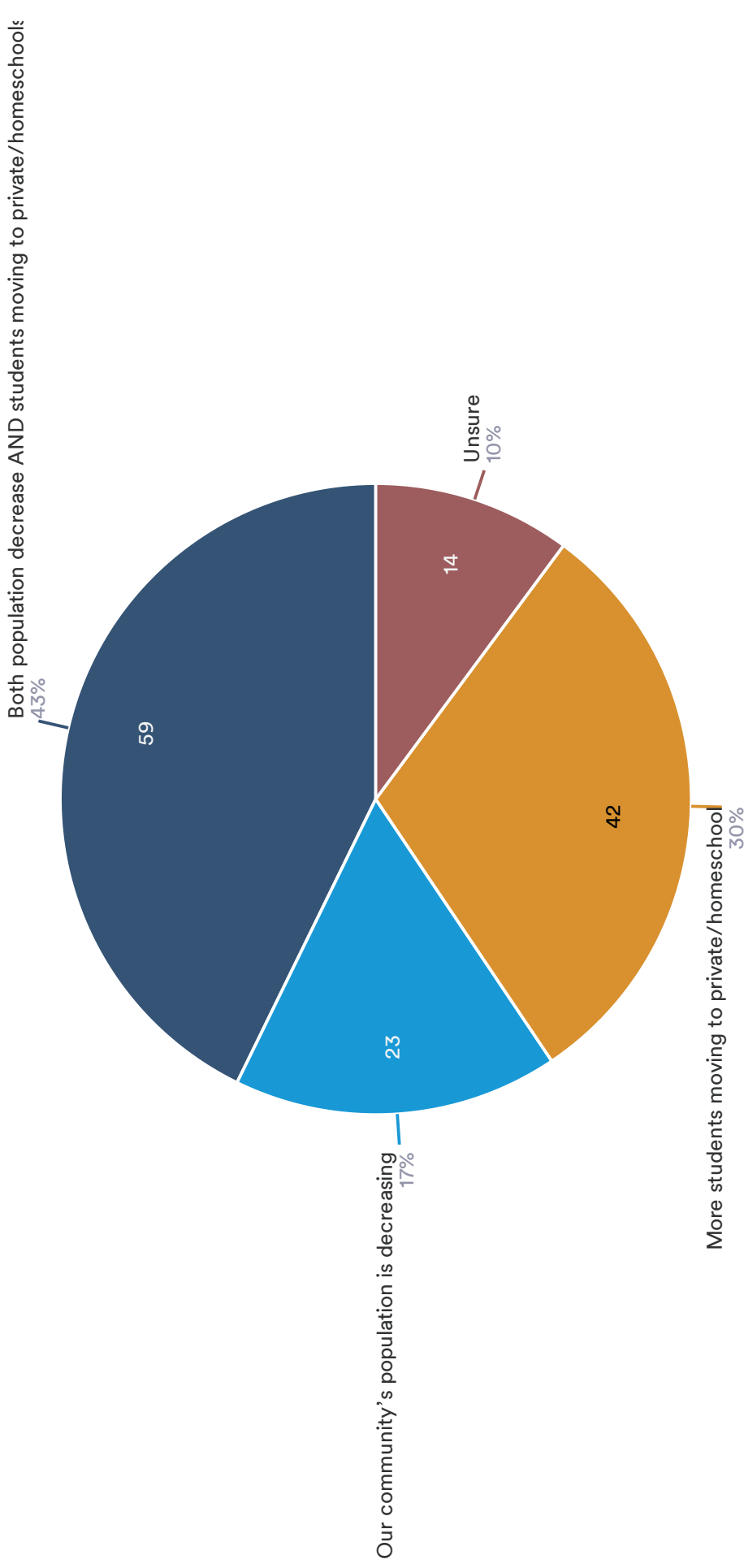

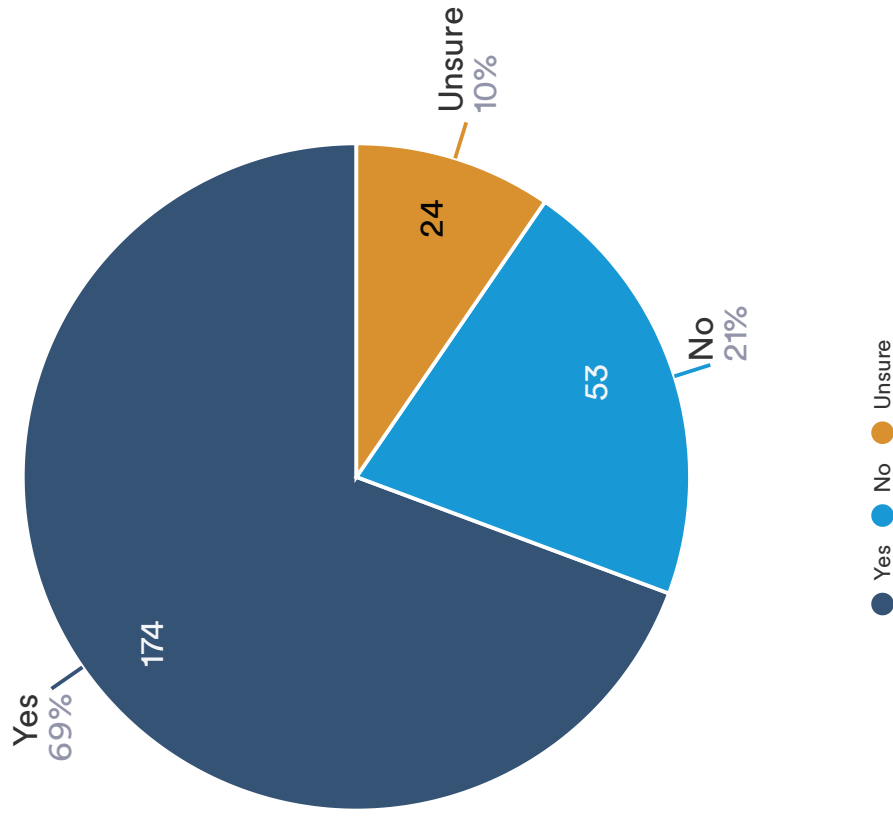
Do you believe the decrease in enrollment is mostly a result of:

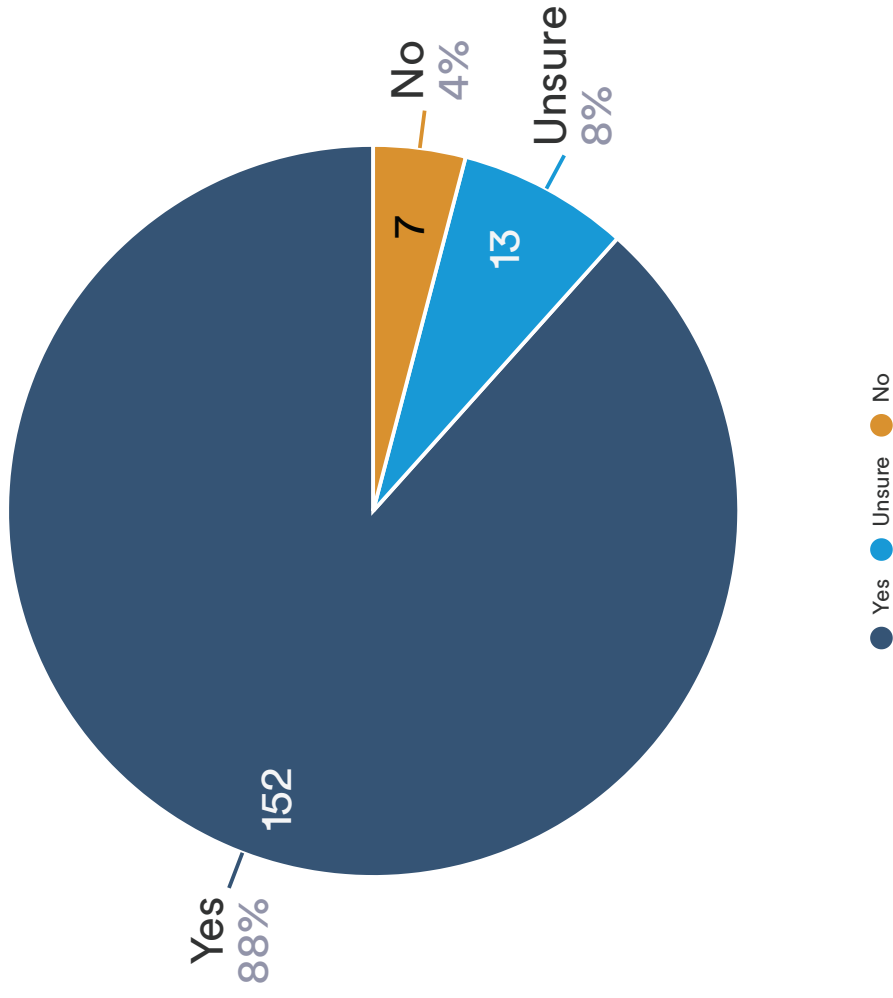
Over the last 2-3 years, has your daily attendance rate fallen

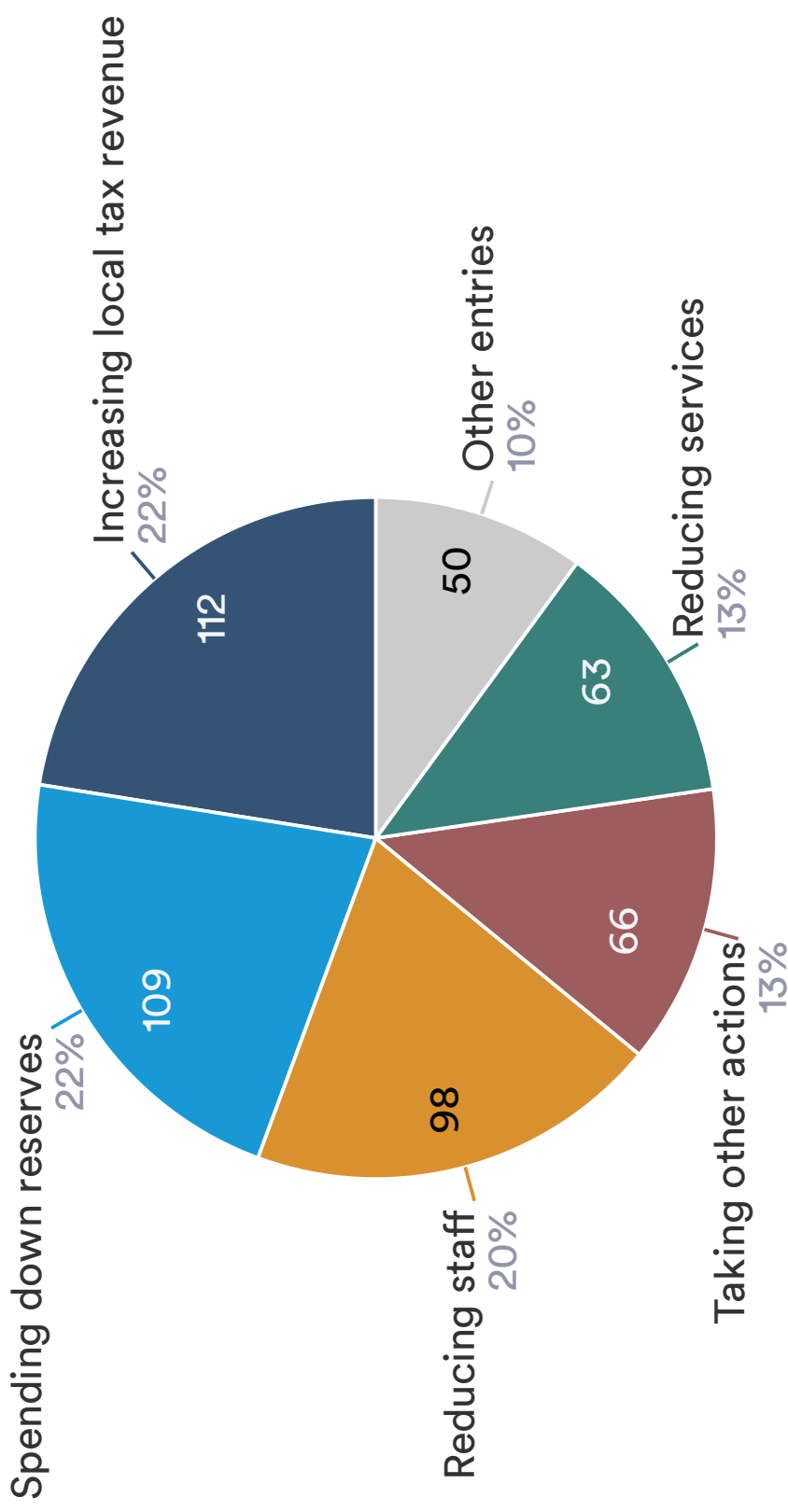
Do you think we need the General Assembly, the court system, and the state child welfare agency to do more to support school leaders enforcing attendance laws already on the books?

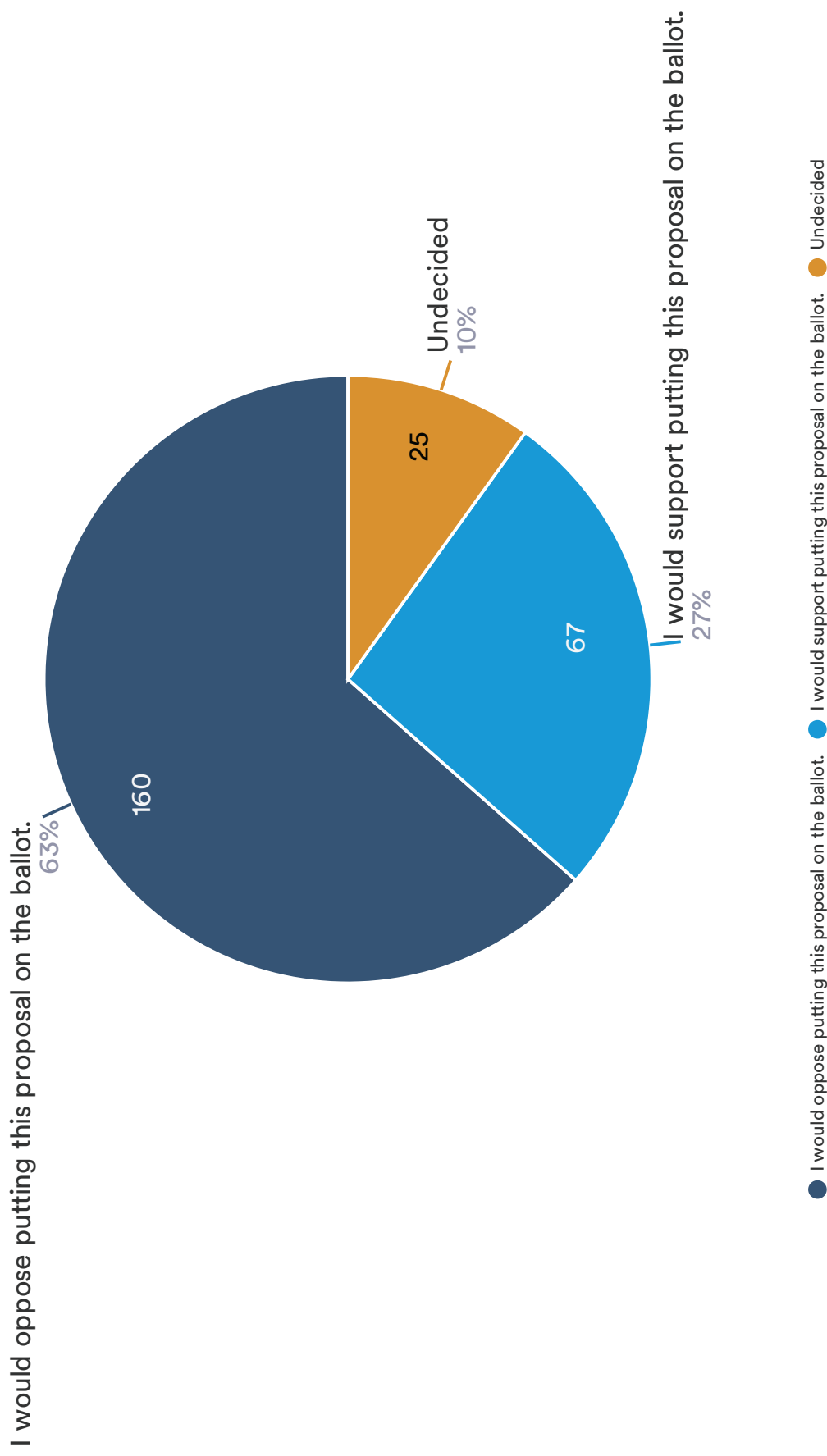
Generally, when enrollment/attendance falls, state funding also falls. If your district has had its state funding reduced for these reasons, how have you responded? (Check all that apply.)

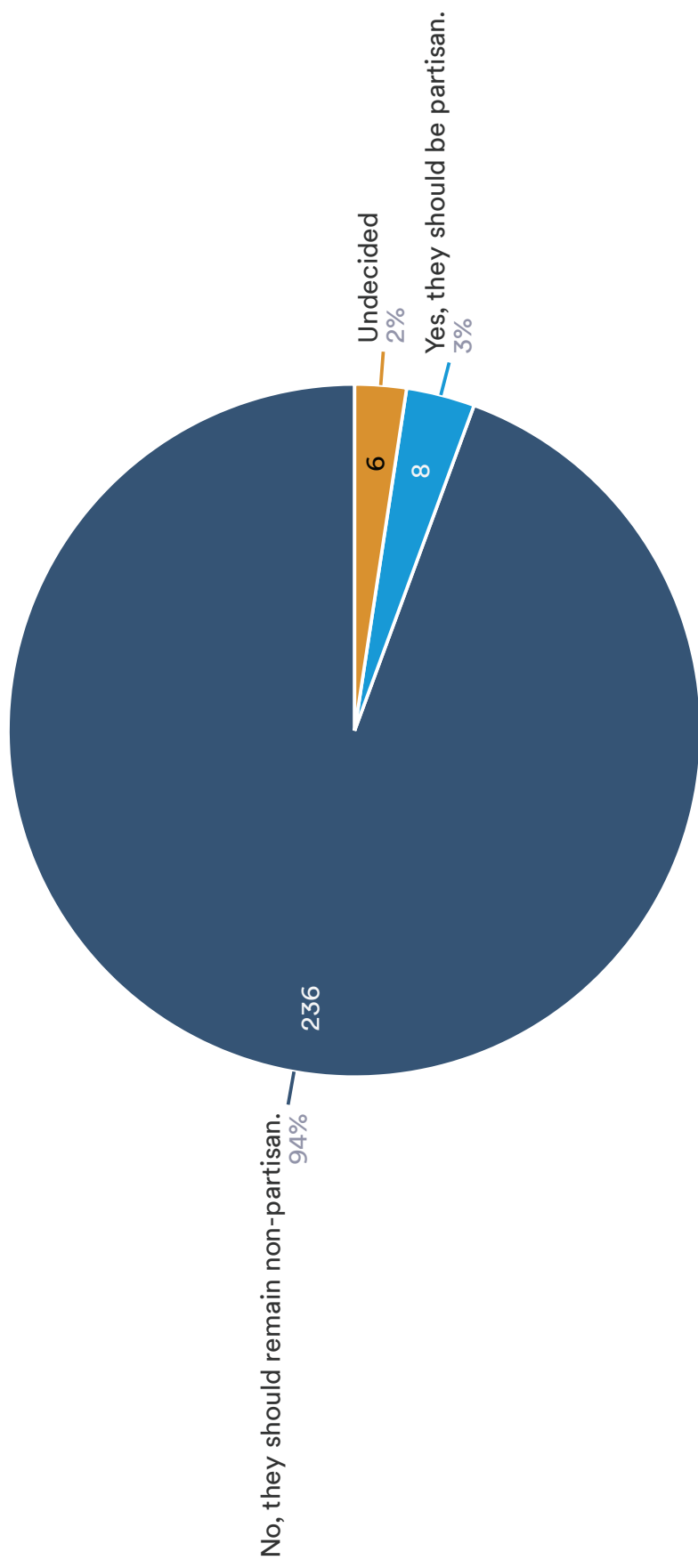
Would you support or oppose putting this issue to the voters to decide?

Would you support making local school boards partisan offices?

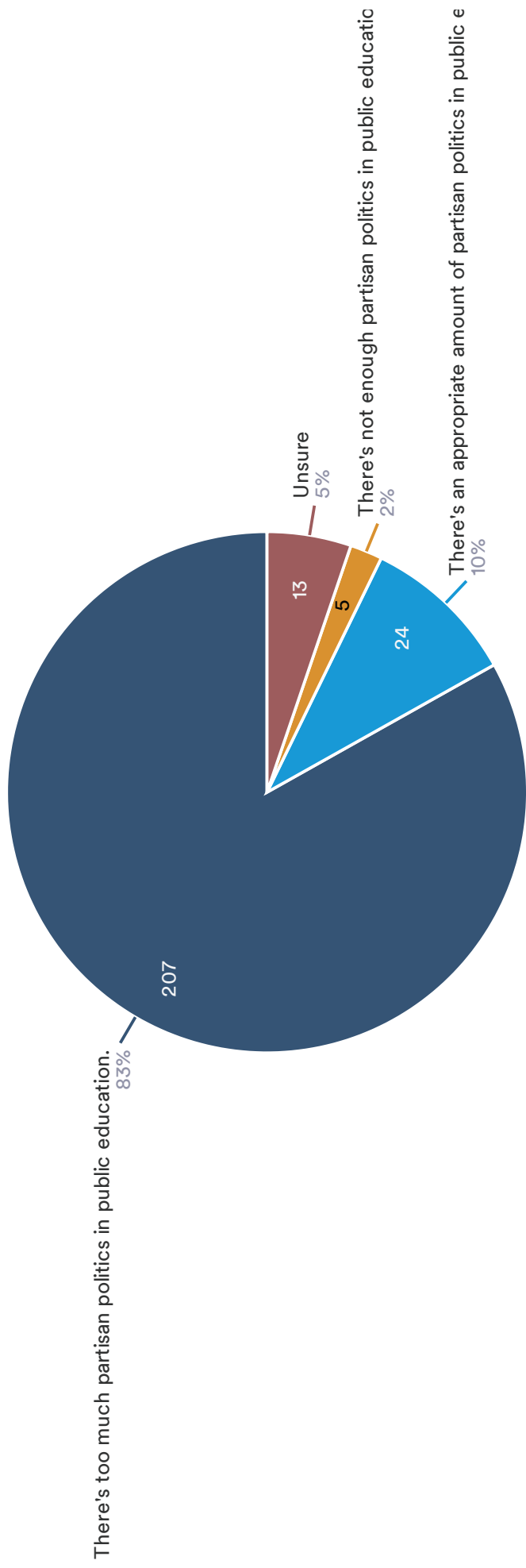

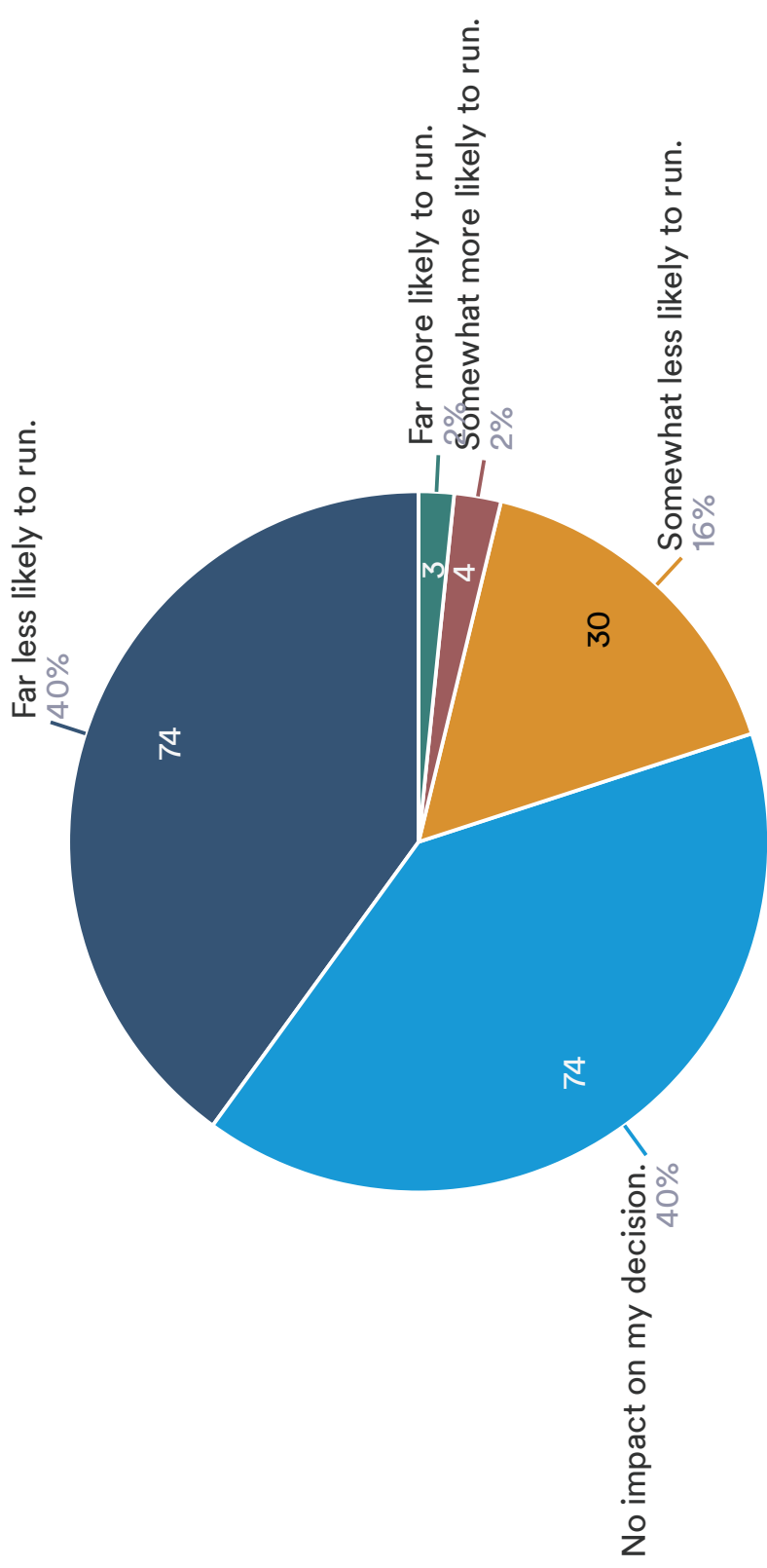

If the legislature passes a bill requiring all future school board elections to be partisan races, how would this impact your consideration of another term in office?

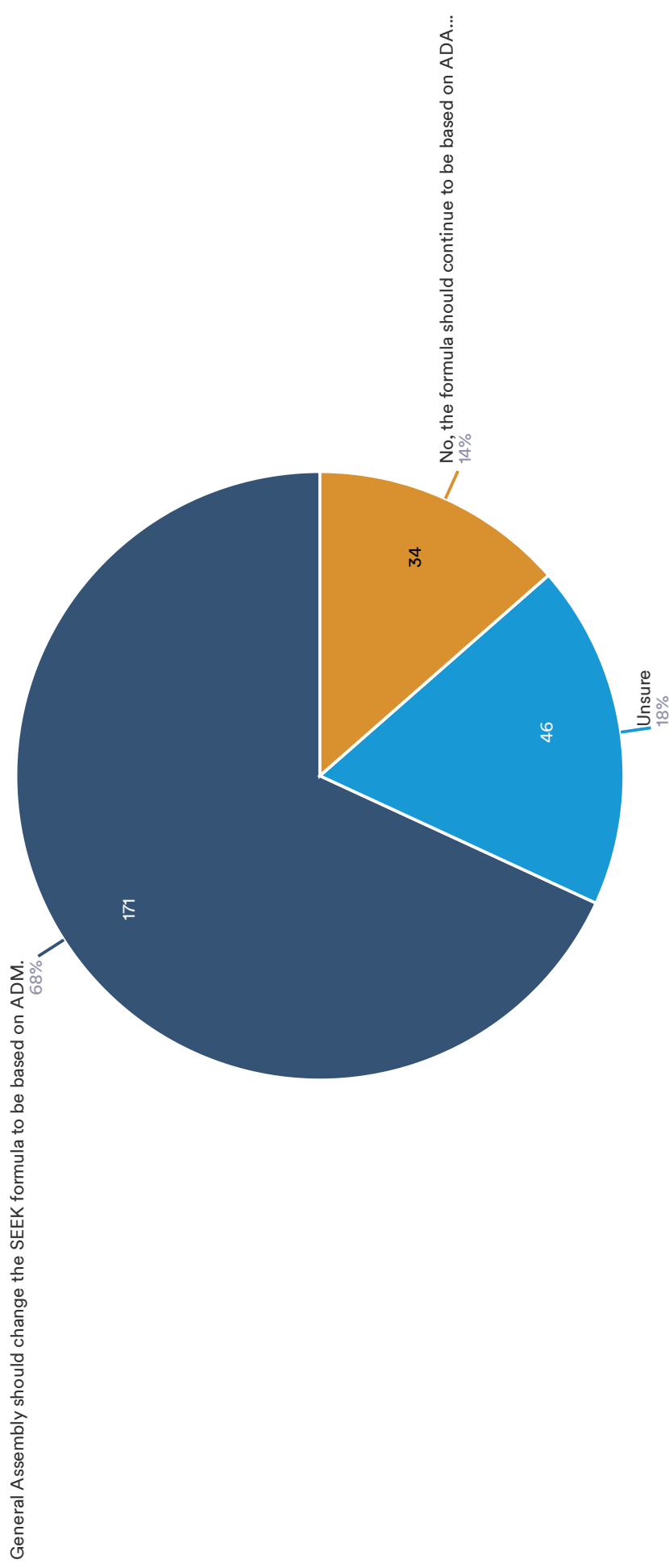

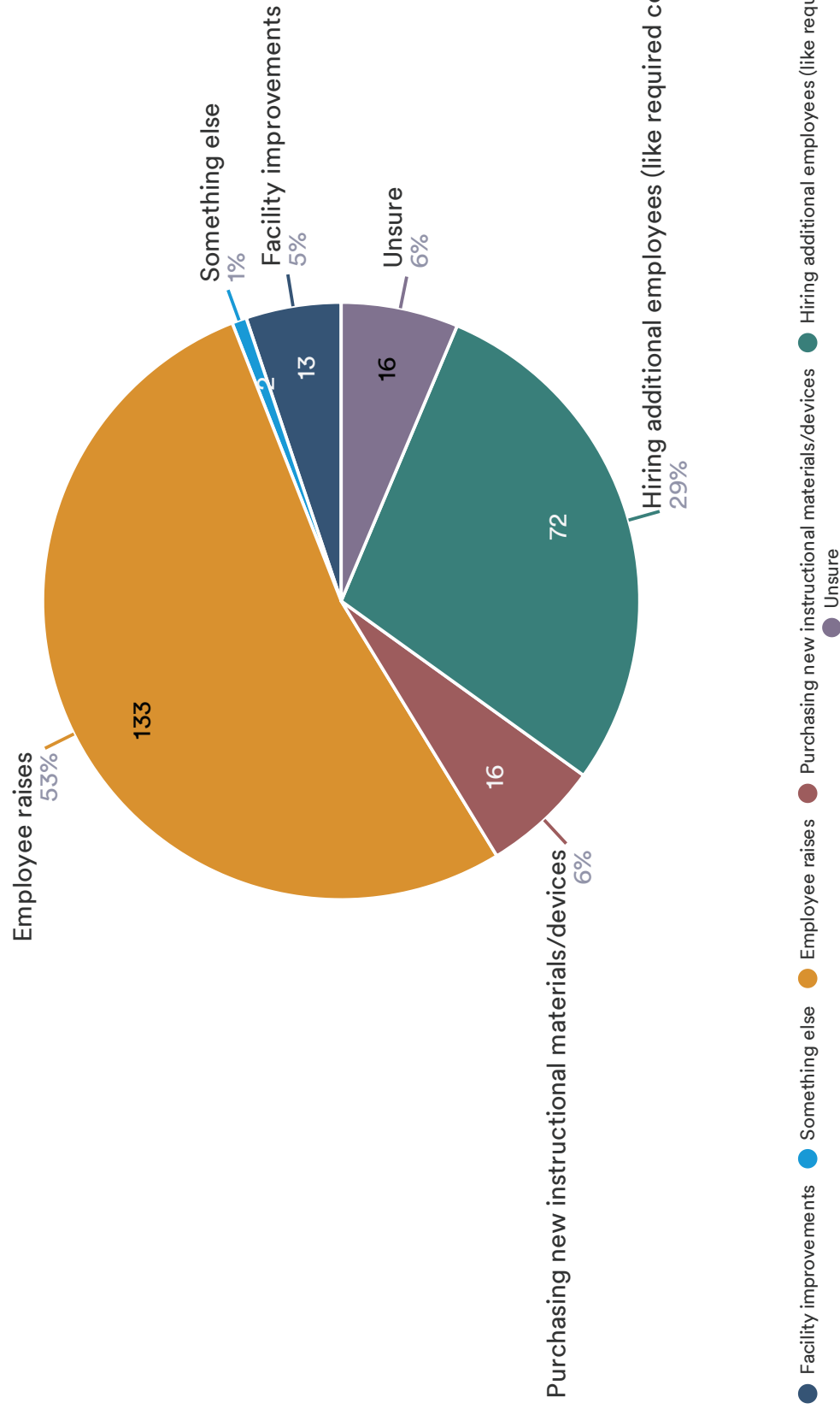

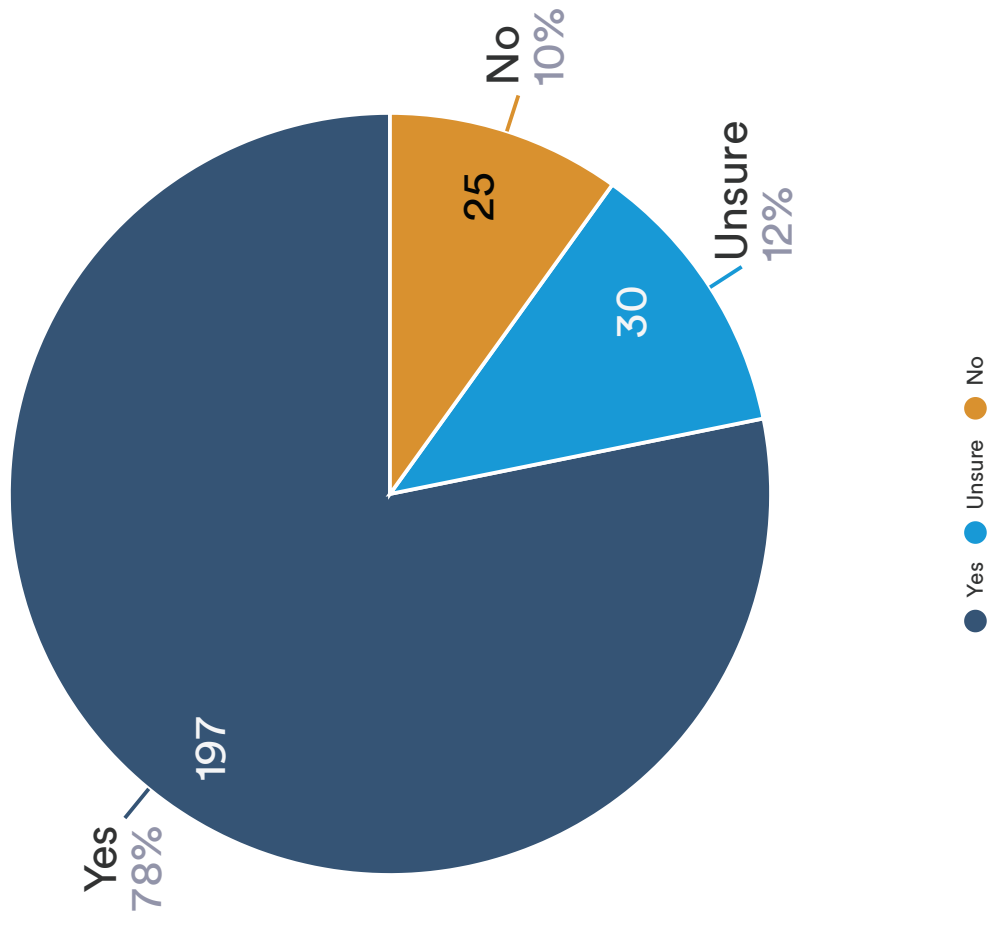
If the General Assembly gave your district a 10% increase in SEEK funding that the local board had discretion over, what would you as an individual want prioritized in the local budget?

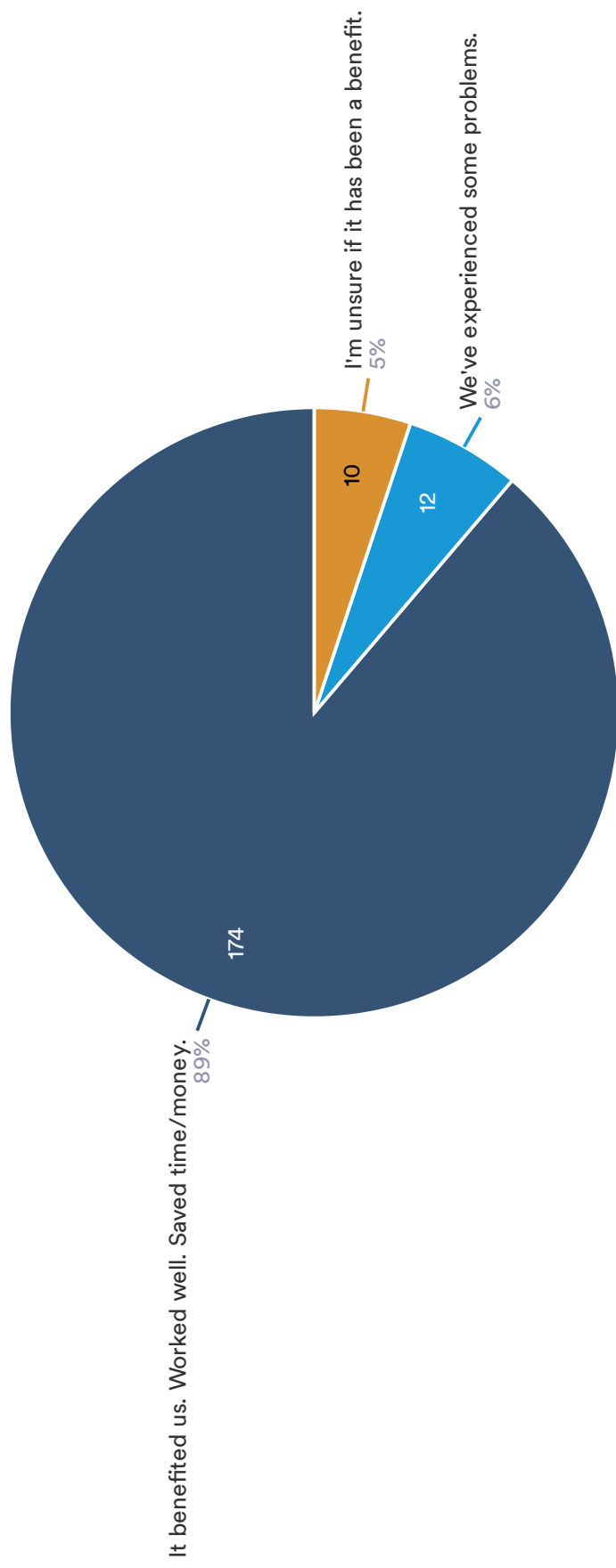
Has your board elected to utilize HB 678?

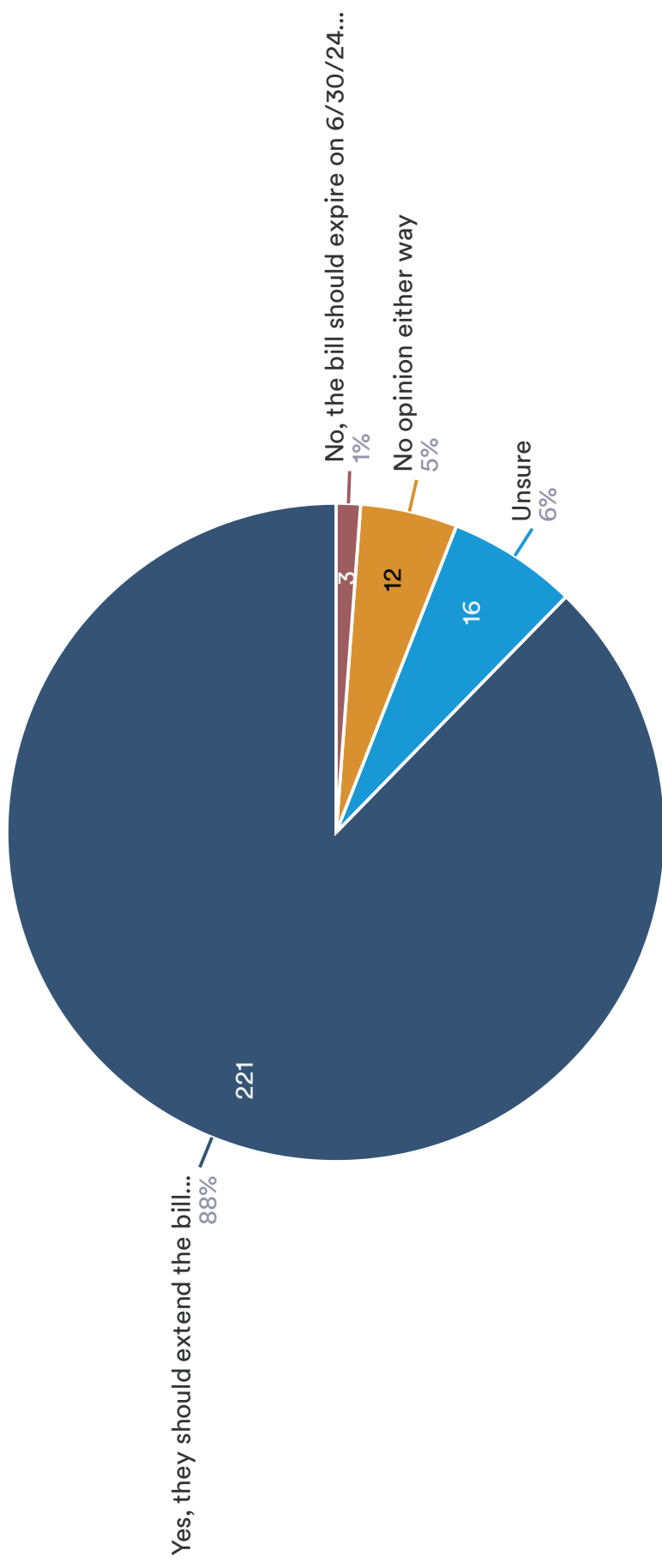
